

Jam e Shirin during Ramadan

Jam e Shirin (JS) is a prime product of Qarshi. It is natural energy and refreshing drink which is distributed among needy and fasting people in Ramadan for breaking their fasts with quality drink and to quench their thirst effectively.

Qarshi Foundation distributes JS bottles to different NGOs, Hospitals, Orphanages, Mosques etc. for distribution in needy and deserving community. During FY 2018-19 total of 71,567 Nos. bottles of 800ml amounting Rs. 12,667,400 were distributed through various NGOs. Some of them are as under:

Dawat e Mashroob

Jam e Shirin is a prime product of Qarshi. It is natural, energy and refreshing drink.

In its Dawat e Mashroob Activity (DMA), Qarshi Foundation establishes Free-Drinking Stalls for general public in various areas. DMA is carried out daily for 8 hours from 15th April to 15th September every year, where poor people quench their thirst during scorching heat of summer season.

Total of 420,000 persons quenched their thirst from natural energy drink.

On this activity an amount of Rs. 3,352,902 has been spent.

Basic Human Right to Freedom

2) There are many inmates in prisons who have completed their terms of punishment; but due to huge amounts against them under the heads of Diyat, Daman, Arsh etc. cannot be released for the rest of their life till they pay the said amount. Qarshi Foundation arranges funds to get such persons released, thereby contributing towards the basic human right of freedom.

Release of Prisoners of Diyat, Daman etc.

According to land of law, these prisoners despite completing their terms of punishment cannot be freed for the rest of their life, till they pay huge amounts (normally ranging from Rs. one to 10 million) against them due to Diyat; which is not possible for them to pay.

Payments made by QF for their release has two dimensions of its impact in society. On one hand the released person and his family get happiness, while on the other hand the amount paid for Diyat goes to the family of victim in this crime, and thereby they get financially benefitted by this huge amount.

During FY 2018-19, Qarshi Foundation paid an amount of Rs.24.7 million to have 29 prisoners released in the categories of Diyat, Daman, Arsh etc.

In FY 2018-2019 Total 63 Nos. of Dowry Cases were facilitated and Total Rs. 1,105,000 has been donated as support.

Qarshi Foundation provides assistance in dowry on open merit through its scrutiny process without any bias of religion, caste, creed or colour.

Moreover, it is ensured that QF does not provide any such support in marriage of minors. This way QF supports 2nd Principle of UN Global Compact by not being complicit to a wrong practice of marriages of minors.
