Communication on Engagement – VED actions

This Communication on Engagement has been prepared as a stand-alone document.

The VED INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY welcomes the opportunity to make a clear statement of its commitment to the [United Nations Global Compact](#) and its principles. It is a description of the practical actions that our NGO has taken to support the principles and to engage with the initiative. These actions clearly relate to the specific activities suggested to civil society participants in support of the initiative.

Ved International Society is an International NGO, headquartered at rural, minorities-dominated district Bijnor in the State of Uttar Pradesh of India. It has been registered with the Government of State of Uttar Pradesh and the Government of India under Act 21 of 1860 and under sections 12A and 80G of Income Tax Act, 1961 since 2006. The donations made to the Ved International Society are exempted from Income Tax and the donor will get a rebate in India as per Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961. It has also been recognized by the Niti Aayog of India.

Ved International Society is recognized by the Department of Economic and Social Affairs, United Nations and is included in the Civil Society Network of United Nations. The Society is a participant in the [Global Compact Campaign of United Nations](#) since 2013.

Ved International Society also partners with The Stop TB Partnership whose Secretariat is based in Geneva, Switzerland and administered by the World Health Organization.

Since 2006, Ved International Society has been serving the community. It organized various discussion forums, seminars, rallies, medical camps, books and clothes distribution ceremonies, tree plantation drives, Medical Camps, Polio Awareness campaign, TB Awareness campaign, Leprosy Awareness campaign, Vocational training programmes, Save the River GANGA Campaign, Anti-Corruption Drive, Women Empowerment Workshops, Solid Waste Management Programmes, Hospital Waste Management Programme, Internet Governance Programme, Financial Literacy Campaign, Voters' Awareness Campaign, Environment preservation and promotion with the help of Environment Protection Workshops, Save the Environment Campaign, Employment Awareness Camps, Save Business – Help Labour Campaign, Organization of community development programmes in association with several educational institutions and others.

The NGO Ved International Society has been providing training to the students and helps them to start their own business, thus promotes entrepreneurship. The society has developed a programme to teach underprivileged children with the help of local Teacher-Educators. We have also started Digital Literacy Program for senior citizens and female rural students.

Main objectives of the organization

- Trees, shrubs, medicinal and herbal plants plantation and start small and medium scale industries based on these products.
- To work in association with state governments and the Government of India and related organizations and institutions with the agenda taken to support the principles of United Nations Global Compact Campaign.
- Organize various programmes like trainings, exhibitions, debate competitions, seminars, plays, essay competitions etc.
- Agricultural, animal husbandry and allied sector development.
- Formation of Exhibition and Amusement parks.
- Work for conservation and protection of various natural resources.
- Cultural Socio-Economic Development by forming Self-Help Groups of women and of low-income peoples.
- Participation in the Societal Developmental activities with a view of Community and Nation Development while promoting Global Peace.

Activities Progress Report for preceding 02 years

The main activities and programmes, organised and managed during 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 by Ved International Society, Bijnor (U.P.)-246701 INDIA are as follows:

1. Hospital Waste Management Campaign at Bijnor Hospitals as a Member of District Committee, nominated by District Magistrate, Bijnor. The Committee was formed in consultation with the State Pollution Control Board.
2. Books Distribution
Our Society has been distributing clothes, books and copies to the needy persons every year.
3. TB Awareness Campaign
Ved International Society, in association with Government Girls' Inter College, arranged a Digital Literacy Camp in 2018-19.

4. Save Groundwater Campaign

Seeing the efforts of our Society in the area of environment, the Society has been nominated in a Commissionary level committee by Ground Water Department, Moradabad (Hydrological) and given the task to make 'Water Friends'.

5. Save Ganga Campaign

In 2019 also, a team of volunteers from Ved International Society with representations of different sections of the society, had gone to Ganga Bairaaj situated at about 15 kilometres from Bijnor District Headquarter, meet people and motivate people to take pledge not to put polythene, etc. in the Ganga.

6. Internet Governance

Ved International Society participated in the Third India School on Internet Governance (inSIG) held at India International Centre, New Delhi in 2018 during 13-15 Oct 2018.
