## Part II. Description of Actions

Actions includes:

- INSANIA has strived to find sustainable solutions to the humanitarian problems in the OIC member states and in the world through feasible development projects in collaboration with NGO's and other International Organizations.
- Building communities, human development by spreading good and eradicating poverty.

Some of the projects are as follows:

- Water projects (building bore wells) – beneficiaries 105,000 people
- Health programs through building / repairing health centers - beneficiaries 715,000 people
- Repairing / reconstruction of school buildings
- Distributing food baskets as part of relief projects
- Building houses for rehabilitation – 122 houses across 5 villages in sierra leone
- Ramadan food baskets (iftar) and building mosques
- Urgent relief shelters and food baskets for Rohingya

All above projects covered many countries such as: Yemen, Central Africa, Palestine, Sierra Leone, Bosnia, Lebanon, Afghanistan, Turkey, Myanmar, Sudan, Uganda, Burkina Faso, Bangladesh, China and Somalia.

## Part III. Measurement of Outcomes

Measurement of outcomes include:

- The above projects have been implemented in collaboration with many NGO's and other international organizations on the basis of covering the ten principles of UNGC.
- Some of the organizations has become participants in UNGC through our support and has been engaged in submitting COP.
- Islamic Council of Donors institution was formed. It is a nonprofit initiative adopted to enhance the integration and coordination of donor institutions in OIC member states in their areas of activities and work.
- For the projects implemented, the basis has been to promote sustainable development and as per the SDG's 2030 of UN.
- Clean & Safe drinking water, educational projects are among some of the goals.
