As a signatory entity of the United Nations Global Compact since 2011, Técnicas Reunidas has decidedly committed to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the 2030 Agenda.

The sustainability strategy of Técnicas Reunidas is transversal and reaches all its activities, both corporate and operational. It includes aspects of corporate governance, environment and relationship with society in a coordinated action between all the departments involved.

This strategy seeks to provide added value, reinforcing the positive impacts and minimizing those potentially negative, and is subsequently adapted to all the projects that Técnicas Reunidas executes. In the longer term, Técnicas Reunidas focuses its efforts on those SDGs with respect to which it has a more direct influence. Regarding SDG 7, "Affordable and clean energy", Técnicas Reunidas designs efficient energy solutions and processes for its clients that facilitate access to affordable, safe and sustainable energy.
