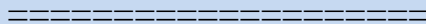
Protection and Safety of Labour : We are running a training center to our H.O. Our movement for labour safety and for their protection on work place includes training, campaign and for prevention of child labour.

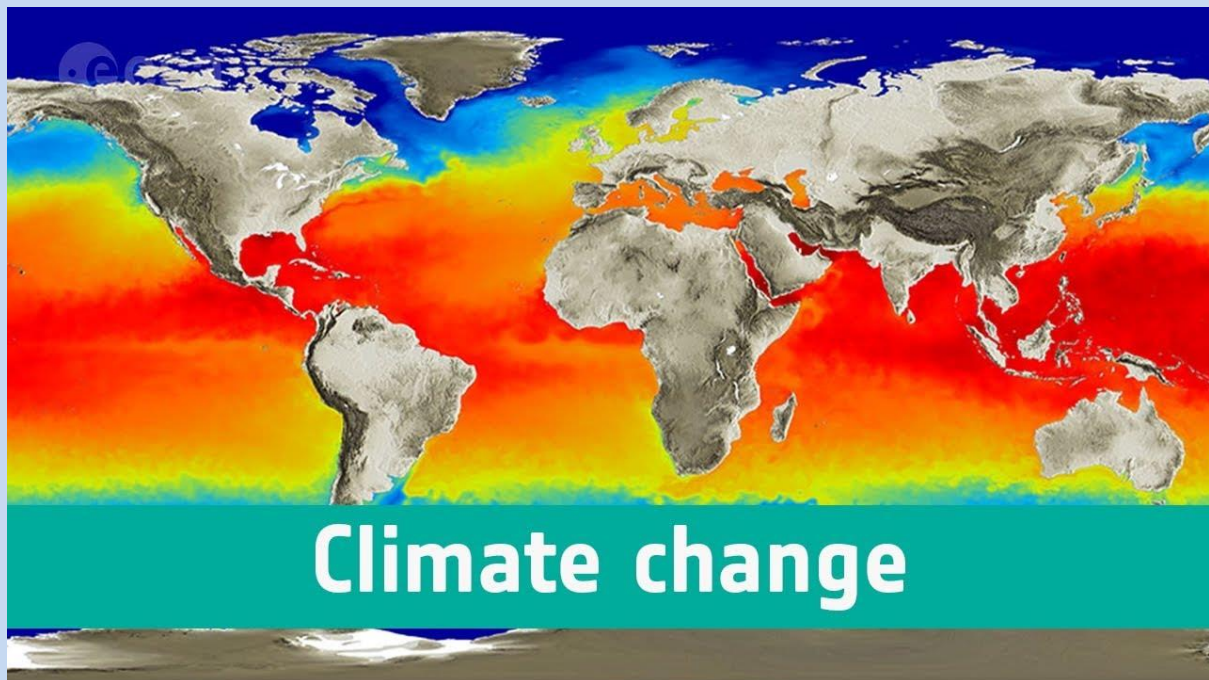
