In this Grace Letter, I am pleased to RENEW that BRIGADA TÁTICA AMBIENTAL, (old: <u>Grupo Tático de Força Ambiental</u> (Environmental Force Tactical Group) or "<u>Guarda Nacional Ambiental</u>" (National Environmental Guard), supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public. We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following way(s):

Our purposes and objectives:

- I preserve and protect nature and combat environmental degradation;
- II to educate, raise awareness, disseminate, mobilize and organize the community to achieve physical, mental and social well-being, based on the fundamental principles of ecology;
- III to promote and / or produce cultural activities, technical, legal, scientific, political, environmental and others aimed at achieving a balanced environment

for humans and all other species;

- IV investigate the unexplored laws of nature and the powers latent in man;
- V to develop prevention activities and fire-fighting in native vegetation;
- VI promotion of culture, defense and preservation of historical and artistic heritage;
- VII the promotion of social assistance;
- VIII free promotion of education;
- IX promoting volunteering;
- X promoting economic and social development and combating poverty;
- XI promotion of ethics, peace, citizenship, human rights, the fauna and flora, democracy and other universal values;
- XII to carry out and promote research activities related to nature conservation;
- XIII promote the creation and maintain tree nurseries;
- XIV disseminating conservation knowledge and principles of sustainable development through their actions, courses, competitions, publications, lectures and conferences;
- XV sign agreements, adjustments, agreements and partnerships, aimed at achieving its goals;
- XVI to involve people interested in ecological and social work of any kind, defined by the General Assembly;
- XVII practice and disseminate cooperative production methods and environmental protection;
- XVIII promoting environmental education, recreation and leisure activities, social and cultural, to integration of the community.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within two years of joining the Global Compact and every two years thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
