

Part II. Description of Actions

In 2019, dr. Lie Dharmawan's Floating Hospital program reached 10 district areas and delivered medical, pregnancy, and dental examinations and conducted minor and major surgeries. Nusa Waluya II Floating Hospital provided care for communities affected by the earthquake, tsunami and liquefaction in Central Sulawesi, while at the same time supported knowledge improvement of local health workers. Aside to that, doctorSHARE also reached communities in the isolated areas in Sumatera and Kalimantan through Flying Doctors Program. Furthermore, doctorSHARE also manages Therapeutic Feeding Centre in Kei Besar Island, Tuberculosis Clinic in Sentani, doctorSHARE Jakarta Clinic, and medical services in Jakarta-Depok-Tangerang-Bekasi areas.

Since March 2020, since the start of pandemic Covid-19 in Indonesia, doctorSHARE has worked and collaborated with Indonesia Global Compact Network and the members of IGCN to support more than 60,972 medical workers, doctors and nurses, provide them with Personal Protection Equipment items to ensure they stay healthy and safety; help them to optimize their works in treating their patients-including their Covid-19 patients.

Part III. Measurement of Outcomes

From 2018 to 2019 doctorSHARE has done health services to 19,571 people in remote areas, conducted 401 mayor surgeries, 1,008 minor surgeries and managed health promotion campaigns to more than 921 people.

Since March 2020 until 30 June 2020 we have distributed PPE to 271 hospitals in 34 Provinces in Indonesia, distributed 14,519 pcs cover all, 3,310 pcs face shields, 929 boots, 3,796 pcs goggles, 581 L hand sanitizer, 26,654 pcs N95, 144,700 pcs surgical gloves and other items needed such as Vitamin C and personal hygiene needs.
