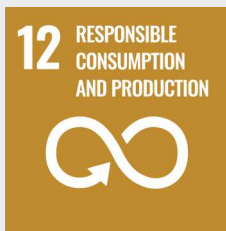
**MAKE CITIES AND HUMAN SETTLEMENTS INCLUSIVE,
