2	Zero Hunger	Food and hygiene packs distribution	270,000 food & hygiene items distributed all over Lebanon 384 food & hygiene packs in the areas affected by the blast
		Hot meals distribution for families and elderlies	6,000 hot meals are distributed each month, on a daily basis, 7 days a week, in Bassma's smile restaurant, and in the damaged areas by the blast.
3	Quality Education	Filling educational gaps of public-school students	One-to-one online tutoring, due to the spread of Covid-19: 100 Private schools' students volunteered to tutor 100 younger public-school students.
