On December 4, 2018, the United Nations Global Compact approved our signature, and we joined the Global Compact Network Japan (hereinafter referred to as GCNJ).

I. Announcement of our policy for promoting mid to long term plans for GC / SDGs.

We have reorganized and formulated a mid- to long-term plan that is management-based and will strengthen our stability. It has been implemented as far as the fourth quarter with the aim of "establishing the KG brand." 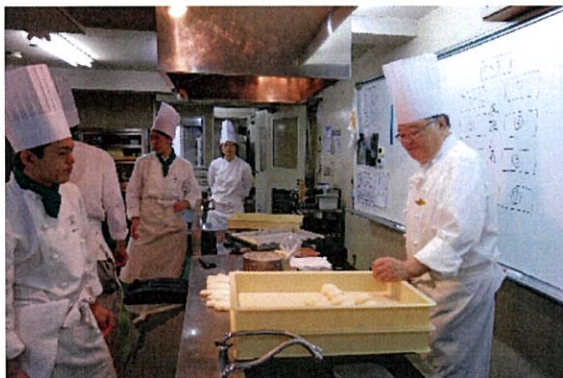
