Outcome of BOSAGORA's Effort to Make a Better World realizing UN SDGs

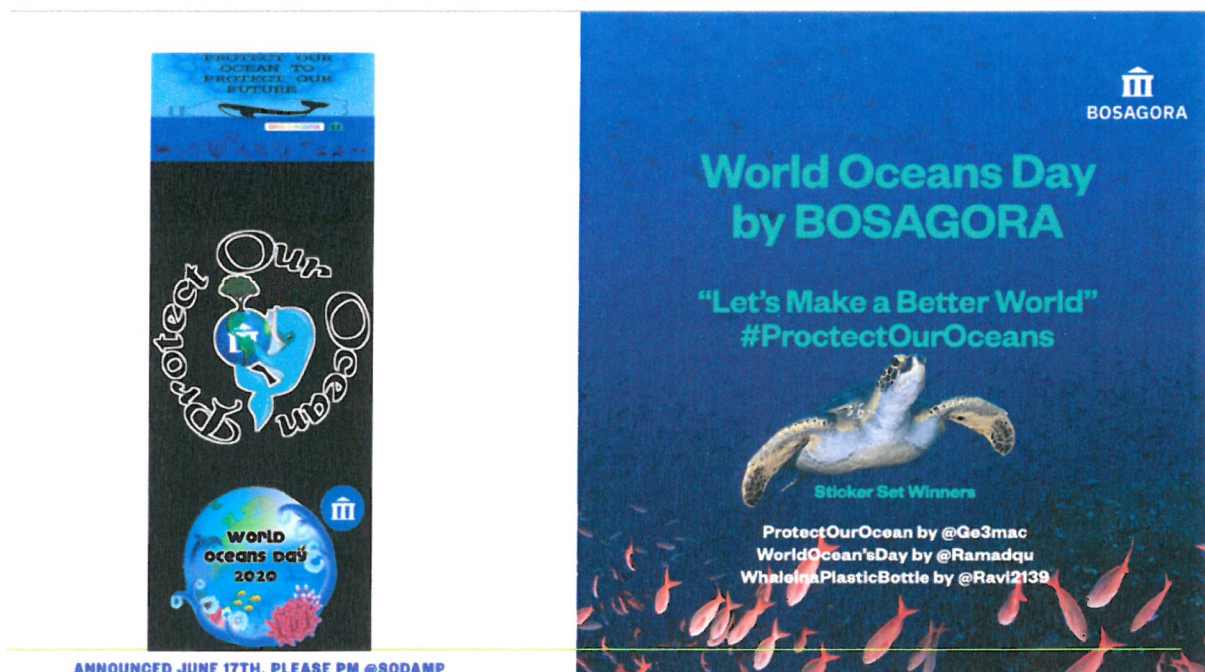
Throughout 2020, BOSAGORA has shown consistent and leading efforts in promoting and participating in UN SDGs. As a result of our profound interest in showing solidarity even in the hardest times heavily ridden with COVID-19, BOSAGORA Foundation was awarded UN Solidarity Awards.

BOSAGORA Foundation practiced solidarity through 'Project Care,' in which many BOSAGORA community members participated in May. BOSAGORA and community members came together to cheer up medical staffs fighting in the front line of COVID 19 crisis suffering from extreme stress and skin damage due to wearing protective gears for long hours. On behalf of BOSAGORA community members, BOSAGORA team delivered 100 sets of Care Packages to Gacheon University Gil Hospital, a hospital solely dedicated to the treatment of COVID-19 patients. These Care Packages consisted of protective products for the skin, beauty facial mask, lotion and various snacks. In each package, cheering messages by BOSAGORA community members were hand-written that were gathered online beforehand.

[World Oceans Day Sticker Campaign]

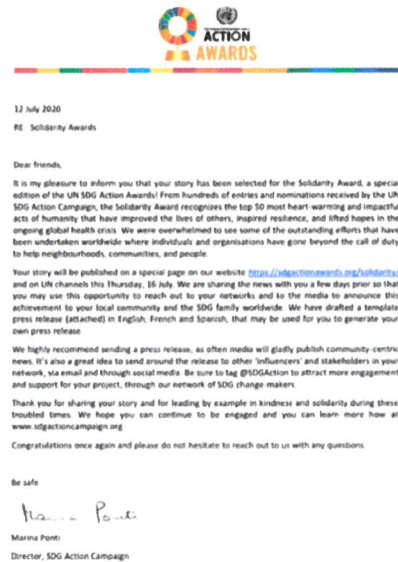
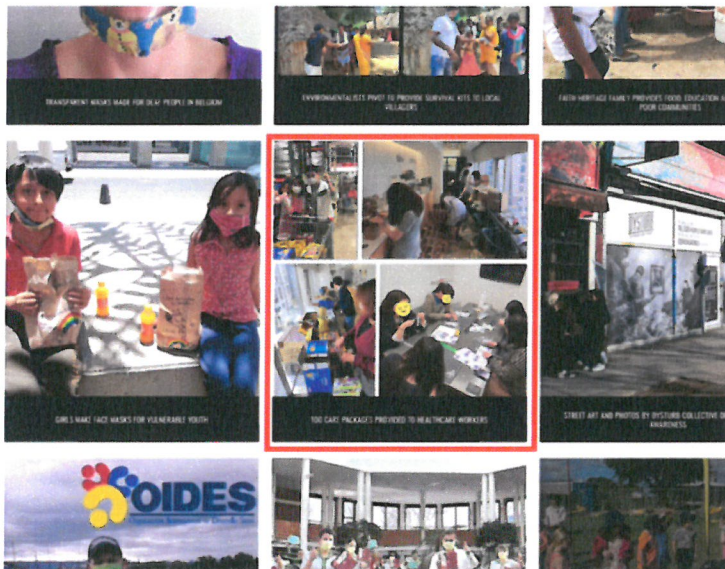

BOSAGORA, which aims to make a 'better world' also participated in by holding a campaign creating stickers considering marine environment and animals with the community. Many people from all over the world participated in the campaign, and among them, we selected and rewarded the work that best represented the message they wished to convey. By doing so, we could expand the bond of sympathy with the community about protecting the environment



[Project Care]

Deadly COVID 19 emerged early this year and mired the whole world into shock is still raging on and threatening the whole humanity. In response, the medical staff around the world in the front line of this fight dedicated themselves day and night in treating and caring for patients.

Touched by such noble acts, BOSAGORA team initiated 'Project Care' to return their efforts and cheer them up donating Care Packages to 100 medical staff in negative rooms stationed in Gacheon Gil hospital. After working a 24-hour shift many healthcare workers suffer from chafed skin due to frequent hand washing and changing of protective gear. In order to help, we created over 100 care packages that included skin products(moisturizing cream, hand cream, beauty facial mask), sweets, and over 100 cheer-up messages from our community members.



[Overcome Flood, Jia You Donation Campaign]

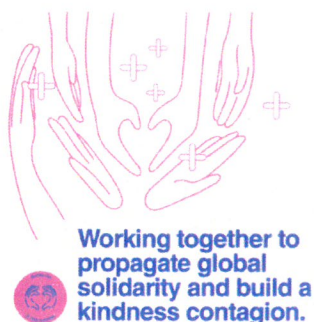
From July 20th to 27th, BOSAGORA Foundation raised a total of RMB 18,300 through its Jia You Campaign, which aimed to help over 40 million flood victims affected by the recent record-breaking flood in China.

This is significant not just because of the amount of money raised but rather the fact that it was a voluntary act of kindness by the BOSAGORA community. In addition, BOSAGORA community members from around the world shared heartwarming messages showing "Jia You" which means "Cheer up" in Chinese online to express support and solidarity. The money from the fundraising campaign for the BOSAGORA project was delivered to the Chinese Red Cross through a Chinese affiliate of Hyundai LCD who collaborated with BOSAGORA during this campaign.

[UN SDG Covid Citizen Action Campaign]



In September 2020, BPF Korea and the BOSAGORA Foundation endorsed the Civil Society Statement, part of the UN SDG's #SolidarityinAction.

The Purpose of the Statement and Covid Citizen Action Campaign is to call for four things to the UN, short, mid and long-term recovery phases, and eight things to be expected of participating countries and supporting organizations.

4 things we urged the UN are as follows:

- Connect immediate response and recovery funding directly with local groups which includes a 'gender marker' for women, marginalized people, community organisations and social enterprises to ensure we leave no one behind
- Safeguard freedom of expression and support innovative approaches to digital freedom of assembly to ensure all voices are heard
- Promote the global ceasefire and support governments to re-direct military spending to social protection
- Call for a ban on the live wild animal trade and a halt to deforestation

[#TurnitAround Campaign]

From September 21st to 25th, BOSAGORA participated in UN's Act4SDGs Campaign, #TurnitAround(www.act4SDGs.org) by encouraging BOSAGORians and community members to retweet and tag three friends to tweets spreading the Campaign.

During this Campaign, BOSAGORA shared its turned-around logo representing its determination to set the change for a truly decentralized, censorship-free, democratic public mainnet. @BOSAGORA1 also tweeted of major changes in crypto including Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC) and turned-around perceptions to enlighten community members the importance of looking at the brighter side of things even in the mist of COVID-19. All together, BOSAGORA #TurnitAround messages received 22k impressions and were retweeted 170 times.
