1. Participation in the Global Compact Conferences at Global and Local Network

- a. The 40 students and 4 faculties of SRCPS participated in the special lecture on" How can corporate organizations help to achieve Sustainable Development Goals" by Padma Bhushan Dr. Kirit S Parikh at ONCG, Delhi held on 5th July 2019. The event was organised by UN Global Compact India.
- The Managing Director of SRCPS, Lakshya Kumar participated in the Virtual Leaders Summit on 15th-16th June 2020 being organised by UN Global Compact
- 2. The SRCPS has incorporated the Global Compact Principles into internal operations and communication. We are promoting the Global Compact principles in our classroom. The students are learning the 10 principles of GC and how they can act to inculcate these principles in their life.
 - a. The SRCPS is remembering and celebrating various important days such as Human Rights Day, Constitution Day of India, UN Day, World Literacy Day, World Population Day, World Environment Day, International Workers Day, Earth Day, World Health Day, and many more.
