Thus, all our projects series the human rights. Regarding labour EADE apply the principle of equal opportunity and select the staff according to their experience and in a transparent method, including different personnel in selection method to avoid any corruption.

In all of our project EADE ensures to coordinate with highest government authorities in target location and to inform the beneficiaries about their entitlements at the beginning of the project to stop any chances for corruption also, by conducting PDMs (post distribution monitoring and offers CRM (compliant response mechanism)

Improving the shelter, WASH, Child protection, Education and livelihoods status of communities will contribute to recover this community from trauma and reducing poverty, corruption, child marriage and etc.. specially by adhering to humanitarian standards in planning and implementing our projects
