One of the greatest challenges facing economies and individuals worldwide is their response to the current environmental and climate emergency, and this has taken on even greater importance since the Covid-19 crisis, bolstering our conviction that we must pursue our ecological and solidarity-driven transformation to build a more sustainable world.

Natixis is also mindful of its role to contributing to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) adopted by the 193 Member States of the United Nations. Natixis identified 11 SDGs to which it has already made a material contribution, one that is set to expand in the years to come, through financing and investments as well as in its daily operation.

Each member of staff here at Natixis has a crucial role to play in this change, and so we constantly endeavor to raise awareness company-wide and encourage our staff's efforts via a range of community and environmental initiatives, as we reduce our use of resources, ensure we manage our buildings responsibly, and promote environmentally friendly mobility practices.

Natixis is the only financial institution worldwide to apply the Green Weighting Factor, which adjusts analytical RWA on our financing deals depending on their climate impact. With this innovative system, we are targeting a financing trajectory consistent with the goals set out in the Paris Agreement on the climate, while we also support our clients in their own ecological transition. Additionally, Natixis Assurances is the first insurer to start aligning its investment policy with the 2°C goal out to 2030.
