# Women Empowerment

## Women Self Help Group Program

The project is being organised in Around 200 villages at present and under the project, more than 700 women self help groups are being managed successfully. The groups are engaged to build capability, saving, confidence and financial capability in poor women and the members of the groups are made aware of



education, health, child marriage, women right and other sensitive issues. More than 7500 poor women have been provided a loan of Rs.17 crore by banks for their economic development, meeting social needs, child education.

- ✦ To increase income level of women through activities related to natural resources and increase access of women to personal and collective resources.
- ✦ To improve social and economic status of women in family and society.

## POSITIVE FATHERHOOD

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan (RSKS) are working for the society since 1992 and bring transformation in lives of more than 55,000 families through our intervention on education, health, livelihood, skill training etc in Rajasthan. In every program or cause we support has gender equality as important pillar. RSKS believes "Gender Equality is not a Women Issue, It's a Human Issue", and we mean it.



With the same thought in 2009, RSKS launched a campaign to promote "Gender Equality" POSITIVE FATHERHOOD as mainstream activity in every project or cause we support. This campaign has sensitized more than 25000 young girls & boys, women and men equality on the deteriorating sex ratio & its long term implications.





## POSITIVE FATHERHOOD

Rural women's employment prospects are severely limited. Like women everywhere, they have primary responsibility for raising children, preparing food, and taking care of sick family members, plus extra burdens, such as collecting fuel wood. Gender roles reduce rural women's participation in labour markets and confine them to lower paid and more precarious employment in agriculture.





## **POSITIVE FATHERHOOD**

In agriculture shift from subsistence to commercial production, As farmers, women grows traditional food crops, while men are more into growing cash crops and therefore are better positioned to capitalize on new market opportunities. Women farmers face systematic discrimination in access to the resources and services needed to improve their productivity, such as credit, secure land title and education.



RSKS believes there is a need to change mindset of the society but that not be possible by working with women alone but to bring sustainable change in behavior men need to be part of it. RSKS do not support any biasness towards any gender because we value humanity over gender issue.



## Stop Violence Against women in India

Approximately, 27933 cases against "violence against women" are registered every year in police stations of the state Rajasthan, India. Under the project, the miserable women in rural and urban regions that are victims of violence, outrage, dowry, exploitation & victimization are getting support by Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, with the help of Global Giving. The victims are being rehabilitated by counselling and skill development training as well as the awareness message for the eradication of violence against women is also being delivered to the male dominated society on a large scale by rally, workshops, seminars, road shows, puppe shows, signature campaign, poster-wall painting, oath taking programs.



### Demand of the project :-



More than 40 complaints for violence against women every day, 10 complaints/cases of rape in every 24 hours and 3 dowry-death cases in every 48 hours are registered in police stations. It is not a fiction but these are the frightening statistics from Rajasthan, India. As per National Crime Record Bureau, 3285 rape cases, 15094 domestic violence cases have been

registered in different police stations in the year 2013. 453 women were murdered of dowry in the state. These victim women don't have any support and help and hence they are exploited more & more. Most of these women don't have knowledge about their legal rights and this lack of awareness and ignorance restrict them to raise voice against the exploitation.

- ❖ To aware the society against "violence against women" and social evils.
- ❖ To reduce the matters of violence against women, victimization, exploitation and harassment.

- To have workshops for sensitive issues as dowry system, child marriage, women right, sex-ratio.
- To organise "Prevention of violence against women" in Pushkar fair and others by road shows.

- To deliver awareness message for "violence against women" in slums and remote villages by road shows, puppet shows, video show.
- To unit public for the eradication of violence against women by organising signature campaign.
- To make children aware for child marriage, save girl and many other such issues by poster competition.
- To send post-cards with the support of public, public representatives and collegiate students to Prime Minister of the country in demanding of getting a strict law enforced to prevent violence against women.
- To get an affidavit filled by public representative and villagers to prevent child marriage and sex-ratio.
- To deliver awareness message in streets among public by poster, pamphlet, wall painting and other published material.
- To provide free consultation to victim women in consultation centres.
- To provide legal assistance to victim women of violence.
- To organise violence against women free awareness tour.
- To organise legal right campaigning for women.





# Stop Violence Against women in India

## Achievements: -

- More than 35000 people are associated with this campaign directly or indirectly.
- Workshop has been organised for more than 75 matters related to violent against women.
- More than 1000 postcards have been sent to prime minister to get a strict law enforced against "violence against women".
- So many women have been benefitted with free consultation by family consultation centres.
- School kids are making their parents awared of sex-ratio and child marriage.
- The campaign is also getting support from social media.
- Victim women of violence got rehabilitated by skill development training, handicraft, garment, bag making, beauty parlour, nurse and other activities.
- It is being endeavored continuously to make some villages free from violence and child marriage.
- Awareness message for the eradication of violence against women has been delivered to the society successfully by more than 60 road shows, street shows, tour(rally), puppet show, video presentations.





## Sustainable livelihood

### Economic Development of the School Dropout Youth Through Vocational Training

Project name Economic Development of the School Dropout Youth Through Vocational Training. The overall objective of the project is to enhancing the employability of 350 Nos. disadvantaged and poor adolescent girls, dropout girls and women's, youth through vocational training & livelihood. The project directly support to 350 Nos. beneficiaries from slum Urban area & rural background includes adolescent girls, dropout women's and girl's youth The activity manly included Vocational and livelihood on Bag making, Doorbell, Rajasthani Hanging & Bandanwad, beautician course Stitching & Western outfit by the Vocational and livelihood Training after the vocational and livelihood training organization

#### Demand of the project: -

The major source of calling for the villagers of the project area, Ajmer, are agriculture and stock raising. But there is a great problem of water in the area and the youth doesn't have any other source of calling. The Government of Rajasthan, has declared the entire region in the category of dark zone because of the villagers can't use hand pump, tube well etc. to get water for agriculture.





### Objective :-

- ⊕ To ensure the employment security and income generation in local sources

## PATHSHAALA : - QUALITY EDUCATION FOR GIRL CHILDREN

The project "Pathshaala . . . back to school" is being managed by Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan to provide quality education to poor deprived girl students. In addition to quality education, poor deprived children are being taught basic learnings of discipline, cleanliness, English under the project.

### Objective :-

- ✳ To increase enrolment of students in the school
- ✳ To initiate the community to advocate for the poor girls to have access to education
- ✳ To increase the access of poor girls to education
- ✳ To change the life condition of poor girls and boys through education
- ✳ To empower their families economically





### Activities :-

- ✳ To provide quality education to deprived children.
- ✳ To motivate children and parents for getting registered in schools.
- ✳ To make children learnt about cleanliness and discipline.
- ✳ To teach deprived children basic learnings of English.
- ✳ To select school drop-out weak children for the getting education in "Pathshaala".
- ✳ To organise entertainment and game activities.
- ✳ To provide study material for deprived children.
- ✳ To make children understand about the importance of education for a better job.



### Achievements :-

- ⊕ Quality education has been provided to more than 300 poor children approximately. 210 children were registered in schools.
- ⊕ Parents are becoming alert and vigilant by education.
- ⊕ The children have got confidence increased.
- ⊕ Other children are also getting inspired and taking admission in schools.
- ⊕ Uneducations is getting reduced gradually.
- ⊕ A positive environment of education is creating in the remote villages and slums which got benefitted from "Pathshaala".
- ⊕ Deprived children are also getting right to education.





### UDAAN: CONDENSED COURSE OF EDUCATION (MIDDLE) FOR WOMEN

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan is managing "middle level (brief syllabus of education)" for marginalized school drop-out women for the development education in which 25 women are taught 2-years middle leanings i.e., studies of 7th and 8th standards. This appreciable initiative has been continuing yet since 2011. In addition to education, women are also made learn some skills. Under the project, exams are also conducted at times to view the efficiency of women.



#### Demand of Project :-

Most of the rural women are faraway from education. As per 2011 sensex, Rajasthan had 66.41% literacy rate which is not so good. The election commission has laid down the standard of education (8th pass) for the candidacy of Gram Panchayat Election. due to this context, the importance of education has got increased for a good leadership. The literacy rate of the state represents illiteracy and backwardness.

#### Activities :-

- ✦ To select deprived women.
- ✦ To teach women by the experts.
- ✦ To conduct exams at times to view the efficiency.
- ✦ To provide women with life skills training besides education.
- ✦ To get theri handwriting improved.
- ✦ To provide basic knowledge of English.



- ✳ To organise knowledgeable games and entertainment activities.
- ✳ To organise sewing training for the development of livelihood.
- ✳ To unit women against the social evils.
- ✳ To inform women about their rights.



### Achievements :-

- ✳ 25 dropout women's are getting education.
- ✳ Women's are taken many events throughout the year and opportunity to develop their talents in different areas.
- ✳ Also support pass out students for further admission and help them in getting scholarship.
- ✳ Benefited with economic activity.
- ✳ Economic upliftment as girls and women and can get part time jobs after school and continuing their higher education and to earn for themselves.



### EDUCATION FOR EVERY GIRL

Rajsthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, with the support of GG, is managing the program in Ajmer to help poor and needy girl studetns. Under the project, study material as pen, books, pencils, colors, note books, uniform, sweater, school shoes, stationery kit are being provided to poor talented students as well as school fee of poor needy students is also being deposited under the project.

#### Objective : -

The main objectives of the program is to provide equal opportunities for education to 7000 poor deprived school kids by distributing study material among them and make those kids and their parents awared towards the importance of education.

#### Demand of Project : -

According to a report of "Sarv Siksha Abhiyaan", 13.20 lakh children of 6-14years age group become school drop-out every year in the state. The survey of Rajasthan Samagrah Kalyan Sansthan reveals that these children have to face so many problems to be educated. It is not feasible for the parents to meet the school expenses (study material) due to the pathetic economic conditions of their families which leads intelligent, talented and ambitious students to get miles away from school education.







### Impact of the Project :-

These poor school kids have got a great help by getting the study material. These children would also have equal opportunities to be education and better opportunities for higher education in the nearest future. The problem of school drop-out and illiteracy is getting reduced gradually. Being educated, the marginalized and deprived students will lay the foundation of development and progress of their region and village. The literacy rate will increase in the state and being children educated will also be helpful for the illiterate parents. Development of education will strengthen the marginalized community.



# Environment & Sanitation



## *Adopt a Tree; Protect Environment & Earth*

The project is striving to materialize the forestation of 11000 plants on the ground in rural and urban region of Ajmer, surrounded by the Aravali Ranges. Public is promoted to adopt trees by planting trees at different places.

Besides that several awareness programs as rally, poster competition are organised for school kids. Public is aware of environment conservation and forestation by poster, pamphlet, wall painting. Under the project, neem, sheesham, peepal, bargad, fruit trees and other conventional trees are planted and being looked after.

### **Demand of the project :-**

According to a report of United States, 9 hectares of forests were deforested every minute between 1990 and 2005 around the world. In other words, an area of 49 lakh hectares had deforested every year and this is an indication of danger. The world has to face problems as climate changing, global warming just because of felling of trees indiscriminately. Many species of animals are at an edge of extinction due to indiscriminate cutting of trees. Five lakh people die every year due to internal air pollution.





### Objective :-

- ✦ To inculcate the habit of cleaning the water bodies from time to time like before rainy season.
- ✦ To motivate them to plant more and more plants and preserving the old ones thus helping in maintaining the fresh environment and climate of the area.
- ✦ To the save endangered species as there is large scale cutting or trees and grazing fields which puts the animals and plants life in danger.
- ✦ The relevance of biodiversity to human health is becoming a major international political issue; scientific evidence builds on the global health implication of biodiversity loss.
- ✦ We need to limit climate change of we wind up with a lot of species in trouble.
- ✦ To maintain the ecological cycle of the biological world.
- ✦ To lower down the level of pollution such as land, water and air in the area.
- ✦ To make people aware about the caused and effects of climate change.
- ✦ To increase the green house coverage in the village.



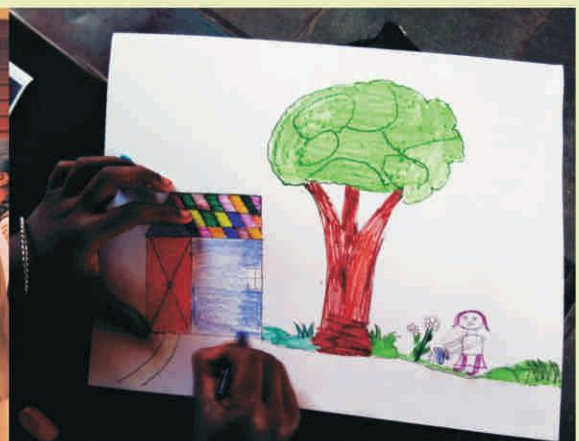
### Activities :-

- ⊕ Awareness through AV show/Nukkad Natak, raillies etc.
- ⊕ IEC activity like poster, wall painting, Banner etc.
- ⊕ Plantation of local varieties of vegetables, medicinal plants, fruits and bio diverse mix of species in community gardens,
- ⊕ Promotion of traditional medicinal practices
- ⊕ Establishment of seed banks and encouraging the farmers for in conservation of seed diversity
- ⊕ Organic manure and vermin composting training to farmers and villagers



**Potential Long Term Impact :-**

- ✦ The environment will be free of pollution by forestation and environment conservation.
- ✦ The matters of asthma, pneumonia and other breath related illness due to air pollution will be reduced.
- ✦ There will be a relief from the biggest danger "Global warming" whether it will be the minimum.
- ✦ There will be significant conversation of environment on a large scale.
- ✦ Greenery will definitely increase and it will rain more.
- ✦ The atmosphere will be less polluted.
- ✦ The species of rare animals will be conserved.
- ✦ Pollution may get reduced.
- ✦ Soil erosion will be less.
- ✦ The society will get better environment.







## Save the innocent Sparrow Birds

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan is installing eco friendly bird nests at different places for the conservation and breeding of sparrow - "the innocent bird" which is going to be extinct rapidly and proper arrangements are made for seed and water for sparrow. Public awareness program is being organized under sparrow conservation project.

### Demand of Project :-

According to bird specialists, there is a reduction in the population of sparrow from 60% to 80%. The micro-waves of mobile phones, satellite towers, chemical pesticides in wheat have become a danger of the existence of sparrow. The species of sparrow are going to be extinct gradually. "Royal society of protection of bird", Britain has listed sparrow in "red list" on the basis of the research of the researchers in various parts of the world including India.

### Demand of Project :-

The main objective of the project is to install 2500 eco friendly bird nests for the species of sparrow which is going to be extinct for its proper conservation and to arrange seed and water properly for sparrow.

### Long Term effects:-

The installation of eco friendly bird nests at different houses, shops, four-ways, public places and trees will help sparrow to build their nests easily and lay their eggs which will be safe by its enemy. The awareness programs will inspire public to save sparrow and the noble work of conservation of the innocent bird- sparrow will be possible.





# Clean India Campaign

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan is managing clean India campaign by the inspiration of Mr. Narendra Modi, the popular prime minister of India and "Father of the Nation" Mahatma Gandhi. Taking this significant initiative, public is being aware of cleanliness by public rally, workshop, road show and posters. School kids are becoming disciplined towards cleanliness by handwash and poster competitions. Apart from this, drainages, wells, roads and handpump are also cleaned from time to time under the campaign. The villagers are motivated not to practice open defecation and to get lavatory build in house and use them.

- ✦ To bring improvement in general quality of life in urban and rural areas
- ✦ Encouraging sustainable facilities through creating awareness and health education, giving inspiration to communities
- ✦ To bring awareness anganwadi centres of rural area with proper sanitation and health facilities and provide active engagement about health education and sanitation facilities to students
- ✦ Focusing on solid and liquid waste in urban and rural areas for entire cleanliness, develop environmental sanitation system being arranged by community

## Activities:-

- ✦ Public awareness and public participation
- ✦ Use of banner, hoarding, kiosk as a communication strategy.
- ✦ Installation of dustbin
- ✦ Free basic health check up

## Achievement:-

- ✦ 125 Dustbin installation
- ✦ Above 12000 rural and urban people were aware about sanitation

## Safe Motherhood

Respectful maternity care with the theme of "Every woman's Right to quality of care for maternal health services. Respectful maternity care (RMC) is a universal human right that is due to every childbearing woman in every health system. RMC Charter is being used globally to talk about the problem of disrespect and abuse during maternity care. It is also being used as a tool to educate health workers about maternity care and human rights, and to raise awareness of the problem in a way that avoids blaming and shaming.

### Objective :-

- ⊕ Formation, launch and capacity building of RMC
- ⊕ Creation of an enabling safe motherhood is a national priority
- ⊕ Integration of family planning and safe motherhood and resource mobilisation

## Kill Malaria, Save Human Life

According to health specialists, 30 crore people get infected from malaria every year and approximately 20 lakh people died from malaria. Under the project, a significant effort is taken to prevent the poor and marginalized section residing at slums from malaria. Distribution of mosquito nets, use of chlorine in wells, cleanliness, public awareness and other programs are held under the project.

### Objective: -

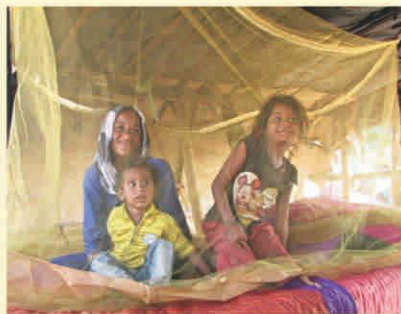
To reduce the human loss every year due to malaria and to clean the dirty areas by awareness programs.

### Requisition of the Project: -

The residents of remote villages, slums get infected easily by malaria due to litter, still polluted water and lack of awareness and treatment. Malaria becomes more infectious in these areas during the rainy season and the entire slum becomes vulnerable to malaria.

### Long term effects: -

The project will reduce the human loss due to malaria every year. Public is getting alert and aware of severe illness malaria by awareness program. The mosquito net will protect children, women and veterans from female anopheles mosquito. The matters of malaria infections will reduce. Anti-mosquito spray will eliminate mosquitoes and the health of the residents of slums will get improved.





## AGRICULTURE & LIVESTOCK

### Vermicomposting

Organic waste, a challenge for disposal, a serious environmental pollutant, and a great social nuisance can be converted, using simple techniques, into useful and valuable product known as 'Vermi compost'. 'Vermi compost' is an organic form of fertilizer with all beneficial properties of inorganic fertilizer but is free from the harmful effects on soil and human health. In recent past with popularity of organic farming gaining, demand for organic fertilizers is increasing. The scope for betterment of soil health using vermin compost and globalization of our economy has opened up new vistas of business opportunity to commercially produce this commodity of multiple social and economic values.



#### Objective: -

- ✿ To make each farm holding self sufficient in its organic manure requirement thus reducing cost of cultivation of various crops.
- ✿ Promoting organic farming through the use of organic manures such as vermicompost and reduced dependence on chemical inputs
- ✿ To provide opportunities for generating additional income to the farmers/youth through sale of compost, earthworms and vermiwash.
- ✿ Upscale the use of vermin composting technology. f
- ✿ Reduce the amount of waste to be land filled.
- ✿ To enhance income of farmers



## Vermicomposting

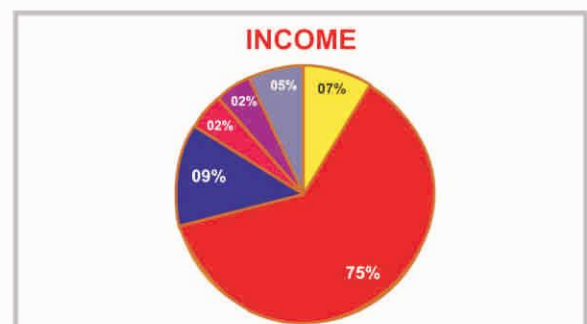
