Dear UN Global Compact Representatives:

EDP Renováveis, S.A. (hereinafter referred to as "EDPR" or the "Company") has been committed to the UN Global Compact corporate responsibility initiative and its principles since 2012, being signatory of this initiative and being committed to put these principles into practice, informing society of the progress it has achieved.

Additionally, in 2015, in the United Nations General Assembly, the world leaders decided to assume a set of global goals to change the world until 2030. The agenda that must guide the joint work of governments, citizens, companies and organizations, consists of 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) with the ambition of ending poverty, fighting against inequality and stopping climate change. EDPR will direct its contributions to eight of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals.

This is the twelfth year EDPR publishes an integrated report describing the Company's performance with respect to the three pillars of sustainability: economic, environmental and social. Information is presented according Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) Standard 101 Foundation guidelines for Sustainability Reporting and also provides information on the additional electricity sector supplement indicators directly related to the Company business, which is the power generation from renewable sources, basically wind.

For the first time, EDPR presented its annual report for the 2020 financial year in accordance with the formatting and markup requirements established in the EU Delegated Regulation 2018/815 of the European Commission (hereinafter the "ESEF Regulation"). Therefore, the digital files of the ESEF Regulation of EDPR and its subsidiaries for the 2020 financial year comprise an XHTML file which includes the consolidated annual accounts for the financial year and XBRL files with tagging performed by the Company, which forms part of the annual financial report.
