DESCRIPTIONS OF ACTIONS

Though last 13 months have been badly affected by the Pandemic Situation due to Corona Virus followed by complete Lockdown then to fragmented unlocking process in our country & our city as well. We being the School & Educational Institution were the first one to be close down completely and are still not fully functional in physical mode. All our education and administration system went into online mode however we had tried our level best to make the best use of that as well.

However there are several activities and campaigns which were conducted during the said period however we are mentioning few of the initiatives conducted by our institution:

1. Plantation drive: A team of 400 students & Teachers have planted more than 728 saplings on the roadside in the unplanted areas of the city and had also decided to take care of these saplings by watering & manure for 1 year so that they are well grown and are able to survive on their own. The team of Students & Teachers was educated to carry out the entire plantation activity on their own which not only will help the environment but will give a lifelong education and awareness to such a big team.
2. Seed balls: More than 10 millions seeds were purchased and were put in small mud balls and was distributed to all 1300 students and their family members and were asked to throw the seed balls anywhere wherever they go in the muddy area.
3. Helping the orphanage: We had distributed mud piggy banks to all 1300 students & 100 staff members and had asked them to put in Rs. 10/- & Rs. 20/- per month in the piggy bank. In the month of October next year we had break open that Piggy Bank and had donated the entire collected amount to an orphanage for their needs.
4. Bye Bye Polythene: Different social awareness campaigns were planned and executed to make our own students, their family members and our staff members to make everyone aware of harmful effects of using polythene. Cloth bags were free of cost distributed to our own students and staff members.
5. Save Mother Earth Drive: This drive includes promotion of Save Mother activity with the sub activities included like save water, no pollution, cleaning the environment, waste management. Lots of promotion was done through students, staff members and spreading the society awareness.
6. Corona Awareness & Help the needy drive: Lots of efforts were made during the corona lockdown to make the life easier for the people and also to spread awareness amongst all. We had distributed more than 2000 face shields, 5000 face masks to Police, roadside street shops, Rikshaw pullers, small shopkeepers and homeless people. More than 400 food packets containing ration for 4 members for a month was distributed to homeless people and their families. Good number of online activities were conducted for students their family members and staff members to make everyone socially connected (despite being in online mode) and also to spread awareness.

5. Save Mother Earth Drive: A great impact has been observed due to this awareness drive in the students and their families as well. Parents are now more vigilant and cautious.
6. Corona Awareness & Help the needy drive: Food packet distribution to the homeless has perhaps saved the lives of many & facemask and face shield distribution along with awareness has certainly reduced the number of corona cases in our city and has certainly helped out government in their efforts.
