Subject: Change in Communication on progress submission date

Dear UN Global Compact stakeholders,

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP).

Following the sale of Bombardier Transportation to Alstom earlier this year and the redefinition of Bombardier as a pure-play business jet company, the company is developing an Environmental, Social and Governance Plan that will be incorporated into its broader business strategy. This year's report will incorporate our new ESG plan as well as the progress made towards our Sustainable Development Goals.

Given this strategic decision, we are requesting a postponement in our annual reporting date, of up to 90 days. This will enable us to post a COP that describes our company's efforts and progress to implement the principles of the UN Global Compact in the context of our new ESG plan.
