RE: Request to extend the deadline for submission of Triple Flag Precious Metals' first COP

Dear Ayman,

As new members of the United Nations Global Compact (UNGC), the original deadline for submission of our first Communication of Progress (COP) was set for June 22, 2021 (one year after joining). By way of this letter, Triple Flag Precious Metals would like to request a two-month extension of this deadline to August 23, 2021. Our rationale is provided below.

Since joining the UNGC, Triple Flag has been working to formalize our Environment, Social and Governance (ESG) strategy and approach. Our Board has recently been formed and approved our first corporate ESG Policy. We have been establishing the governance structures required to oversee and meet our commitments and working to establish goals and a small number of specific targets to guide our work. Included in this work has been a commitment to be carbon neutral since our inception in 2016. To accomplish this, we recently purchased certified carbon offsets equivalent to the greenhouse gas emissions of Triple Flag and the attributable portion of the GHG emissions from the mining operations in which we invest, from 2016 – 2020.

Additionally, last week we closed on our IPO and are now a publicly traded company on the Toronto Exchange. As I'm sure you can imagine this has been a long, labour intensive exercise and while we continued to advance our ESG activities concurrent with the process, we would kindly request additional time to prepare a succinct COP for submission as the IPO has absorbed much of our time and limited resources.

We are currently working on our first Sustainability Report and would like to integrate our COP within this report to streamline our public reporting and avoid duplication of effort. We plan to launch our Sustainability Report in July 2021. For this reason, we are requesting a two-month extension for submission of our first COP. Going forward, we plan to update our public reporting on an annual basis, readily meeting the annual COP requirement.

Please don't hesitate to contact me should you have any questions or require any further information. Triple Flag takes our commitment to the UNGC very seriously, and we look forward to publicly reporting on our progress in implementing the UNGC Principles this fall, and annually thereafter.
