We seek to use tried and tested approaches to promote mental well-being and support positive cognitive development to break the vicious cycle of mental illness from continuing through adulthood and having a detrimental effect on the quality of life of the individual. With poverty being one of the leading causes of the problem, efforts were made to train the parents on how to be self-sustainable.

COVID-19 emergency response –

An emergency response towards COVID-19 has been undertaken by OPAD with support of AHF and other partners.

Target group

Reach 16,000 households with corona virus messages as per our current project plan 2. Support 1,000 adolescent mothers with nutrition and food supplement 3. Distribute sanitizers and soap to 1,000 underprivileged people in the community 4. A total 1,000 underprivileged children with nutrition and food supplements

Activities Achieved } Distributed 2,000 personal hygiene, masks, hand sanitizers and soaps products } Provided 8,000 health talk and community awareness of the messages among adolescent mothers through Posters, and Videos. } Protective cover to prevent COVID-19 and T-shirts.

FOOD DISTRIBUTION

Objectives.

To support communities in the fight of hunger during COVID-19

- To protect community workers in the frontline during their work.
- To respond towards emergency needs, such as distribution of food supplements.
- To educate the community on the importance of nutrition during COVID-19

Target group.

A total of 120 vulnerable households and 600 beneficiaries supported with food supplements at Kakote villages Shantumbu. 2: Reached 1600 vulnerable people with messages on nutrition.

Activities achieved:

Distributed food supplements such as beans and soya pieces to 120 households and 600 beneficiaries. 2. Reached 1600 vulnerable people with messages on nutrition. 3. Reached 1600 vulnerable people with messages on gender-based violence.
