I write this Grace Letter to request that Technical Assistance to Non-Governmental Organizations (TANGO) International, Inc. receive **an additional 90-day grace period** for submission of our annual Communication on Progress (COP) report. We recognize that the COP is a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact, comprised of a CEO/President statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact and a description of practical actions with regard to the Ten Principles, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes. I confirm that TANGO continues to support the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labor, environment, and anticorruption.

The past year (2020-2021) has been an unprecedented time for our company, and indeed the world as the COVID-19 pandemic continues.
