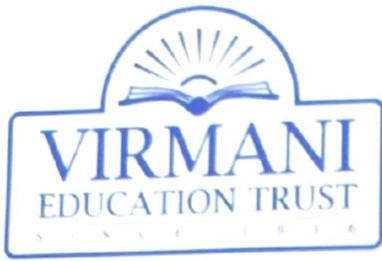

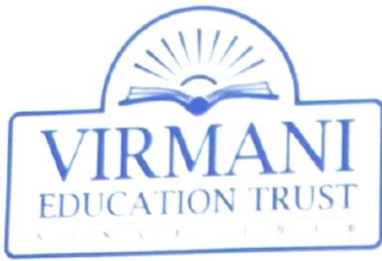

- **For Educational Sector:** In the last financial year the trust has **provided free education to over 20,000 illiterate women.**
- **For Empowerment Sector:** Employment provided to over **900** household women.
- **For Covid-19 Relief:** Covid-19 Relief provided to over 240 families.
- **For Skill Development sector:** Over 22,000 women are earning after learning numerous skills.
- **For Financial Aid:** Educational Scholarship over Rs.5, 00,000 (Rupees Five Lakh) were provided to students who got admission in NIT Universities for their higher studies. Moreover, our organization took care of the 50% of their whole course fee.
