## Examples of BEMA commitment to UNGC:

- b. September 2013 to October 2021. Expressed to all members, nonprofit, consultants, and private industry members since BEMA acceptance in UNGC to completion of online anticorruption awareness training via UNGC website.
- c. October 2019 October 2021. BEMA International has promoted in lieu of global health restrictions attended United Nations Water Mandate and other humanitarian assistance, education & training opportunities virtually.
- d. **January 2020 March 2020.** BEMA International registered and planned to attend United Nations general and ECOSOC meetings in the United States as members of the UNGC, but due to COVID-19 restrictions U.N. events for onsite attendance were cancelled.
- e. February 2021. Nominated and accepted the Deputy Chair, Global Health Security Agenda Consortium (GHSAC) within the Global Health Security Agenda (GHSA) position of with the United Nations and other international nations, private sector, and organizations are permanent and chairing members for the prevention, response, and recovery of global communities from pandemics.

From the examples above BEMA has been and shall continue to take part in the activities of the United Nations Global Compact, and express to members, partners, associates, and collaborators of our membership in the UNGC to further the 10 Principles in conjunction with the sustainable development goats (SGG's) for the sustainability and resiliency of their organization and communities.
