PART II. Description of Actions

- Establish and convene Sustainability Disclosure Community (SDC) to help achieving SDG target 12.6.
- Participate as an Endorser to the UN Principles for Responsible Banking (PRB).
- Develop '[Corporate SDG Impact](#)' booklet, based on Guidance on core indicators (GCI) for entity reporting on contribution towards implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals, to encourage companies to integrate SDGs contributions into their sustainability reports. The GCI was endorsed by the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting (ISAR).
- Continue to engage/assist companies in SDGs implementations.
- Consistently promote corporate sustainability practices and the SDGs through the following activities:
 - Deliver workshops and training on topics related to corporate sustainability and SDGs implementations.
 - Develop booklet in relation to corporate action on sustainable development.
 - Disseminate corporate sustainability framework and the SDGs.
 - Provide support to companies in their own sustainability implementation and disclosure efforts.

PART III. Measurement of Outcomes

- 125 organizations participated in the Sustainability Disclosure Community (SDC).
- 115 organizations assessed in according to GCI. The results were included in the [State of Corporate Sustainability in 2020](#), the biennial (2-year) report indicated the corporate SDGs performance based on company public disclosure.
- More than 800 listed companies rated on ESG factors and selected into the [ESG100 list](#) (the 100 outstanding ESG performing listed securities in Thai stock market) and the [ESG Emerging List](#) (the attractive listed securities with promising ESG progress).
