Statement by the President of the International Emergency Management Organization

Following the decision of the IEMO Executive Committee to provide every two years the Communication On Engagement (COE) “expressing continued support for the Global Compact and renewing the participant’s ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles” the Organization has established to provide to its Members relevant information on the various modalities of support to the Global Compact in specific areas, identified for its specific organizational type (Public Sector Organization). For 2019-2021 the IEMO Executive Committee established to report on the following area with a measurement of results : *Join and/or propose partnership projects*

The Years 2019-2021 have been marked by the outbreak of Covid-19 Pandemy and therefore the activity of the Organization has been focused on react to the sanitary distress : in particular the Organization has provided masks and gloves for needy people and remitted two ambulances for hospitals in Senegal, with the aim to help local rural communities. Therefore the IEMO has provided assistance and support to actually implement UNGC Principles through effective aid and support to rural communities.

Qualitative and quantitative measurement of results: the activity of IEMO has benefitted a large number of over 10,000 beneficiaries and, at the same time, spreading the UNGC Principles through its humanitarian assistance.
