## Part II. Description of Actions.

We conduct individual work with parents and teachers in the following areas: pedagogy and psychology, law, information and computer security, analyze the content of user activity in social Internet networks.

In the course of monitoring activities on information social activity in educational institutions, we carry out information patronage in the following areas: research of accounts in social Internet networks, detection of potential cyber risks of involving minors in destructive communities.

We carry out the detection of conflict situations in the studied educational team, record such manifestations, with further notification of teachers about incidents and identified aggressive manifestations among students. We analyze the risks of destructive impact based on the collection of analytical data on the involvement of minors in destructive communities, with further prediction of the involvement of students in informal currents of an illegal nature.

According to the appeals of parents, guardians, legal representatives, we conduct a survey of social activity on the Internet on the submitted account of a minor, identify possible risks and conduct a detailed analysis of the pages.

We have done a lot of work, conducting monitoring studies on the Network, identifying and identifying new trends of destructive trends in the means of communication.

Every year, tens of thousands of pages of groups engaged in the dissemination of negative, harmful information for children have been transmitted and are being transmitted to Roskomnadzor and other government agencies. We have prepared a website page on which any Internet user can independently choose a state body to submit an application for illegal content in accordance with the subject of the appeal. We provide assistance to parents, teachers, conduct consultations in various fields, by the organization, as well as with the involvement of specialists. In the future, if desired, we coordinate the necessary measures.

We prepare and distribute memos for parents, conduct lectures with teachers, presenting them with the necessary tools to resolve conflict and dangerous situations for minors. We are working to identify negative online communities, destructive orientation, potentially dangerous for minors: incitement of ethnic hatred in the adolescent environment; social inequality among the adolescent audience; non-traditional forms of interpersonal relationships; suicide, parasuicide, other dangerous forms of behavior, for example, anorexia, self-harm ("selfharm"); distribution of video images with real footage of people's deaths; psychoactive substances, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, "vaping"; tattooing as a form of destructive deviant self-expression; "hooking", "ruffering" and other dangerous actions that subsequently lead to the death of children; involvement of minors in early sexual relations, prostitution, use of children as an object of porn business; abuse of people and animals, violence against animals and bullying of people; introduction of death;

denial of generally accepted norms of morality and morality; involvement of teenage children in participation in mass riots; aggressive manifestations against teachers, parents, society, individual social groups. These are just some of the destructive currents that are in the process of constant renewal, which are spreading in the information environment of youth and children's communications.

The work carried out by our organization in recent years to identify and prevent information risks on the Internet has allowed us to identify potentially dangerous areas of negative influence on young people, as a result of which we find and offer solutions that help reduce risks for children, provide teachers and parents with the necessary tools to ensure the safety of minors, come out with constructive proposals to public authorities to implement cybersecurity programs.

Self-isolation has exacerbated many communication problems and created new potential risks. We can state that the number of disinformation messages in mass mailings in messengers and social networks has increased. Information attacks cover all sectors of society. Investigating the motives of all cybercrimes committed, we came to the conclusion that almost all of them are based on the presentation of false information, further manipulation, misleading, intimidation, blackmail. Thus, all programs aimed at reducing cyber risks without processing upto-date information, identifying false information distributed on the Internet, and communicating the collected information to the general public in order to form a critical approach to information will be ineffective. This is the innovation of our approach-in identifying new trends of disinformation that affect almost the entire society, building programs to counter cybercrime using the latest data. We have also summarized the most common questions about the use of distance learning technologies and will cover the most relevant topics during the events. Work on the project will be carried out in target groups: schoolchildren, parents, teachers. The effectiveness of achieving the goals will be realized by holding a set of events with the participation of parents, legal representatives of teachers, the project team, and involving volunteers:

1. Monitoring and analytical activities: training at least 10 volunteers to legally collect and record information, conduct sampling in social networks of groups with destructive content and minors who are in them. Analysis with classification by region, passing information to the project team. In the future, take the necessary measures and provide assistance within the scope of competence, based on the current legislation.

2. Methodological and expert: preparation and release of materials: recommendations, algorithms of actions, memos, presentations, for parents, teachers, schoolchildren.

3. Public events: informational and educational, training, lecture halls, seminars. Possible application of distance learning technologies:

a) from parents, legal guardians, teachers training group seminars;

b) minor: lessons from media security, network behavior, introduction to health save technologies;

C) round table with the participation of the concerned officials of relevant ministries and departments, law enforcement agencies, and the public;

d) regional webinar with teachers;

4. Consulting services. Individual psychological and legal consultations, possibly with the use of remote forms, by phone, in person. The main results of the project will be: improvement of competencies in the prevention and combating of cybercrime in the designated target groups, further application of knowledge.



Due to the special importance and danger of the crime, the investigation was conducted by the central office of the Investigative Committee. 35 examinations were carried out.

**October 1, 2020** The Center Save the Children from Cybercrime is one of the organizations that helps law enforcement agencies identify destructive groups on social networks, including those involving teenagers.

Specialists of the public organization have repeatedly saved the lives of children and helped put the curators of the "death groups" in prison. The head of the center, Sergey Pestov, is sure that there is nothing for teachers to do on this virtual battlefield.

"Despite this, teachers are sometimes recommended to view the social networks of schoolchildren. It's one thing if a teacher wants to communicate with a student on the Internet. Even special class groups are created in social networks that can be useful for the educational process. Another thing is when teachers are forced to evaluate the pages of children in various public places. "The state should actively support non-profit organizations specializing in providing psychological and legal assistance to the population. 
March 5, 2020, the Public Chamber of the Russian Federation hosted an expanded meeting of the working group on the development of the information society, mass media and mass communications.
