#### 1. Free Health Camp – March 11, 2019

# 3. Free Health Camp - May 31, 2019

We successfully conducted Free Health Camp with Health Screening of students of Nagarjuna School with total 160 students from Play group to Class 3. Students were provided Free Medical Checkup and Counseling from Senior Consultant Pediatrician. Whole body health screening was provided to the Students.





# 4. Free Health Camp – July 16, 2019

We organized Free Health Camp with Lab Tests Package at ICFC premises on 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2019. ICFC 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary program with Coordination with Blue Cross Hospital and Red Cross went successfully and ICFC Staffs were happy and satisfied with our Services and Management.
