Part II. Description of Action

Still, in the continuity of our determination to promote social dialogue and promote the integration of the less deprived in DR Congo, and in a challenging context of Covid-19, Congorganize has continued its support for access to education for all and specially to work on raising awareness of the fight against and prevention against Covid 19 which has ravaged the world since 2020. The most important thing is that for 2020-2022, Congorganize has established a detailed program to raise the awareness of communities in their support for implementing the Sustainable Development Goals by 2030.

As in previous years, our actions have promoted a good understanding of Global Compact actions in DR Congo. Among which there are:

- From October 2020 to 2022, we continue to work on projects supporting free primary education in Congo after four years. This period was particularly given that the pupils should stay at home and Congorganize helped some families to have access to the teaching of the proximities which consisted in providing teachers of the houses to keep the level of

the pupils during the schools were firm. This strategy has supported the accompaniment of primary education in DR Congo. To this day, let's continue to support 50 students.

- In its strategy to promote youth entrepreneurship and job creation, since mid-2018, in its social enterprise program called "Makala Eco," this strategy has expanded into a vast project of a farm proper. Since January 2021, Congorganise has trained young people on agribusiness and started several agricultural projects in Mbanza Ngungu (Central Congo) and Kimpoko (Kinshasa).
- In the health field, Congorganise has become a pioneer in prevention against Covid-19. Thus, since the start of the 2020-2021 school year, Congorganize has made several prevention elements against this pandemic to allow students to study safety. For example, there are masks, gloves, or hand sanitizers among the materials distributed. In addition, by June 2022, we plan to spread the test kits at home to selected schools in Kinshasa.

- CongOrganize continues to support the efforts of the local network to promote the principles of the UN Global Compact in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.
