### **Our activities**

We fight to expand the population's access to health in the public and private spheres (SUS and Health Plans), training doctors and raising awareness of the signs and symptoms of the disease to guarantee an accurate and early diagnosis for various diseases .

We also work to update Clinical Protocols and Therapeutic Guidelines, so that patients receive adequate treatment; and we fight for new technologies to be made available free of charge to patients with different health conditions.

Still within this objective, we work for greater transparency of public spending and to ensure that the health budget is allocated in the best possible way, benefiting as many Brazilians as possible.

## **Our activities**

We work with campaigns to prevent chronic non-communicable diseases and through partnerships, I claim We recommend that the government include more public policies for attention to cardiovascular diseases, which are now the leading cause of premature death in the world. We mapped the journey of the Chagas patient, considered by the UN as one of the neglected tropical diseases, to identify ways of diagnosing and treating these patients early, thus increasing their quality of life and lifespan. .

We carry out several campaigns mobilizing society to participate in government decisions to include important free treatments in the public and private health network for various types of cancers, respiratory diseases, rare diseases, among others.
