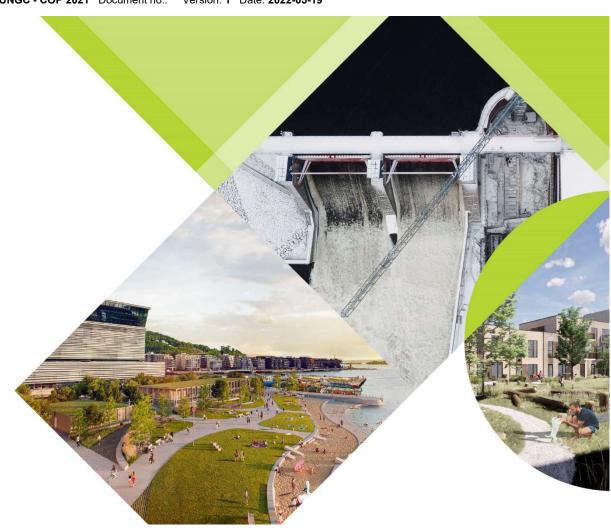

1 Sustainable development-thinking in everything we do

Sustainable development is a question of looking after the external environment and human health and building good communities using economic and cost-effective solutions. Norconsult will contribute to development that meets the needs of the current generation, without compromising the needs of future generations.

Sustainability is a cornerstone of our consultancy activities. Through creative and innovative processes, we give advice and develop solutions that take account of the environment, climate, social and financial conditions, and that are put to use to create value for our clients and society. We want to encourage our clients and partners to make sustainable choices, while reducing our own negative impact on nature and the environment. We believe that this will provide increased competitiveness for our clients, both in the short and long term. Sustainability is integrated into Norconsult's strategy, organisation and management system.

Sustainability was one of the strategic topics in the company's strategy for 2019–2021, and this has been continued in the strategy for 2022–2024 with the aim of achieving sustainable development in everything we do. Our sustainability strategy is based on four overarching goals for the Norconsult group:

- Carbon neutrality in our own operations by 2030
- Increased share of green turnover
- Management and reporting
- Organisational and competence development

Our projects, our employees and the company's climate and environmental footprint are particularly important for the company. Our projects must offer environmentally friendly solutions that take account of social conditions. We must comply with rules and authority requirements, act in an ethically and environmentally appropriate manner, and we must reduce our own impact on nature, the environment and the climate.

Norconsult has chosen to make a commitment to a positive development of society, which is made visible by participating in organisations and schemes that promote sustainable development across companies and industries. Norconsult AS is, in addition to being a member in the UN Global Compact, also a member of Skift – the business climate leaders, SAMMEN2020, the Green Building Alliance and the industry network Grønn anleggssektor (Green Construction Sector). Norconsult has also signed up to the Guide against Greenwashing.

Norconsult works systematically to improve deliveries and environmental performance in projects and our own activities. As part of this work, certification under the internationally recognised standards ISO 9001 (Quality Management) in Norway, Sweden, Iceland, Poland and the Philippines, and ISO 14001 (Environmental Management) in Norway and Sweden, has been important for documenting compliance with regulations. This work has also provided a system for continuous improvements and ensuring satisfactory compliance throughout the organisation. In 2021, Norconsult was also certified to ISO 45001: Occupational Health and Safety. Further, a total of 45 office locations, and the head office in Sandvika, are certified under the Norwegian Eco-Lighthouse Scheme.



2 Our commitment to the UN Sustainability Goals

As a major player in the construction sector, we want to be a part of the solution to global, national, and local sustainability challenges. Norconsult will actively contribute to the green transition and to the UN's sustainable development goals. Norconsult aims to contribute actively to improvements in society, in collaboration with other players in the industry.
