Description of Actions:

We are committed to work towards the United Nations and its Ten Principles and have demonstrated this through the following:

- Attract youth participants to the UN Global Compact through awareness on events and activities.
- Creating international exchange opportunities for young people to develop leadership capacity through practical learning in challenging environments.
- Hosting and delivering events and talks related to the Ten Principles.
- Providing resources to 16 local chapters at universities to promote and discuss ways forward for the Sustainable Development Goals.

Measurement of Outcomes:

- Annual conferences that focus on the areas of the Ten Principles and bring together like-minded organizations (3 total for the period measured).
- 14 global internship opportunities created in 2021 with businesses in the United States where we aligned on shared values and created a workplace of high integrity and equal right to professional development.
- 279 J1-visa sponsored interns and trainees between June 1st, 2021 and June 7th, 2022 contributing to cross-cultural understanding.
