- **The star** in the middle of the shield is the source of bright shining star. Also is the symbol of God as Source of Life.
- In the middle there is a map of Papua Island where Uni Papua was first established, where the organization come into existence and progressing for the first time.

Yellow Papuan ethnic motives is symbolizing the richness of cultures, arts and creativity being displayed in Uni Papua Logo and become a spirit boost to protect the positive values own among the communities.

The red colour is symbolysing the real function of blood which is to tie the oxygen to deploy to every parts of the body. It is also indicates bravery. Within the light formation/frequency the red colour is the lowest which can be caught by human sight.

This color is a warm and positive color associated with our most physical needs and our will to survive. It exudes a strong and powerful energy. Red is energizing. It excites the emotions and motivates us to take action. It signifies a pioneering spirit and leadership qualities, promoting ambition and determination.
