Welthungerhilfe continues to use a review process of potential partner companies. In our review process the membership of the Global Compact is one important criterion and we suggest all checked companies that are not a member yet, to become a member of Global Compact.

Promoting good business practice

Welthungerhilfe regularly attends events on sustainability to promote the SDGs and business practices in line with the Global Compact.

Food security standard

Welthungerhilfe, together with partners, developed a standard for value chains that guarantees food security to smallholder farmers. The standard can be integrated into certifications and is being used by several companies.

The measurements and actions of the standard are in line with Global Compact's principles.

Project work

In many of our projects in developing countries we link development work with private sector activities, where we promote fair business practices. For example, Welthungerhilfe facilitated fair contracts between companies and smallholder farmers in Sierra Leone and Zimbabwe. This results in companies that act in the spirit of Global Compact's principles.
