We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a CEO statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

This summer, the unpredicted circumstances met all of the Polish. The Russian invasion on the Ukraine caused a serious trouble to the whole Polish transportation and logistics system, including its vital nodes that are the ports. We are now in a very busy period and we are continuously engaged in ensuring effectivity of the cargo flows – particularly cereals and energy resources. Our work is now focused on actions required to secure capabilities to export Ukrainian grain to compensate bottlenecks in the global supply chains.

Therefore we kindly ask for an extension period in order to be able to post our COP that describes our company's efforts and progress to implement the principles of the UN Global Compact. Our new COP report will be posted on the UN Global Compact website by 30th November 2022 at the latest.
