Introductory Word of the 2021 - 2022 report







Ladies and gentlemen,

On behalf of Airtel DRC, I am delighted to present our activities and achievements over the past year which meet the objectives of our UN Global Compact commitments. We are very proud to support and uphold the principles of the UNGC and we strive to reflect these principles throughout the work we do in DRC.

While 2021 presented numerous socio, health and economic challenges to people across the world due to the lasting and continuining effects of the global pandemic, Airtel DRC has carried its core values of Solidarity, Dynamism, and Respect across all of its activities to ensure it continues to successfully make impacts across the country within the UN's core principles. Our wide-ranging CSR activities, detailed further in this report, have worked to contribute towards the UN SDGs 4 "education", 3 "health and wellbeing", 17 "partnership", 12 "responsible consumption and production" and 11 "sustainable cities and communities".







Reflecting on just a few highlights from the year; we made an important contribution to improving access to education in DRC. Our "You me Global" initiative showcased future scholarship programmes carried out under the patronage of the US government such as "You-me live", and "You-me academy" and contributed towards digitalisating the education system in DRC. Moreover, Airtel DRC worked closely with the Ministry of Education and Science to organise the announcement of the results of the State Examinations and the launch of the e-Diploma. Airtel DRC was able to significantly reduce the waiting period for diplomas for students across the country through its intervention, leading to a positive uptake in university enrolment.

In addition to our ongoing work to raise awareness on health and safety issues, including supporting regional communications on the COVID vaccination programme, Airtel DRC provided an emergency response when the volcano erupted in Goma. We sent out SMS alerts to share information, awareness and resettlement details to residents, as well as donating 50,000 bottles of water in collaboration with the World Food Programme (WFP), which carried out the distribution.

In our role as ambassadors for the UNGC principles, Airtel DRC was pleased to support the UNGC with the organisation of a high level conference on "Fighting Corrupting: the role of the State in the fight against corruption" at the Dutch Embassy. The panel raised awareness on corruption with discussions led by esteemed panellists including the Director of the Inspector General of Finance, Prof Luzolo Bambi, and Former Minister of Justice and the Advisor to the Head of State, Mr Bashala.

Airtel DRC is proud to be part of the global network of UNGC members that works hard uphold sustainable development principles for the greater good of societies across the world. We recognise that global collaboration is critical to realising the UN's sustainable development goals.

In 2022 and beyond, Airtel DRC reaffirms its commitment to making a positive impact on the lives of local communities in DRC.
