PART II: DESCRIPTION OF ACTIONS

During the period covered (2022-2022), EUCLID continued to deeply integrate Global Compact concepts in its activities and curriculum. A specific course (code UN-SDG) dealing with the UN sustainable development goals developed in 2020 is now part of our recommended curriculum.

In compliance with the logo use guidelines, EUCLID has continued to raise awareness about the UN Global Compact values and network whenever possible, especially in regions/countries where knowledge of the Global Compact is limited (Central African Republic, Gambia for instance).

EUCLID has continues to expand its partnership network and engagement with several networks and associations related to UN Global Compact objectives, such as The Consortium of Universities for Global Health (CUGH) and the Global Consortium on Climate and Health Education (GCCHE).

In planning development for 2022-2024 and beyond, notably developments in business projects (including entrepreneurship entities), UN Global Compact principles were reviewed and taken into account.
