
However, at Live Love, this has been our fuel, the reason we're waking up every morning to go to work: To help those in need.

INTRODUCTION

Live Love Beirut was founded in 2012, born out of the need to find hope in the midst of an everlasting national turmoil.

It all started with a bracelet, and a hashtag #LIVELOVEBEIRUT.

The idea behind it was that no matter what was going on, when we'd wear the bracelet, we would have to look for beauty and news of human kindness around us. Find hope, capture it and share it. 




1.1-ARCHITECTURE & PLANNING

BUILDING BACK BETTER

Following the blast, a new unit was born at Live Love. Our team is made up of Architects, Engineers, and Planners that have been fully dedicated to rebuilding the city using the highest standards and following international guidelines and procedures in order to build better homes and spaces for people. Our team has been mobilized for over a year now, assessing damages on the ground. The Architecture team is committed to making people's lives better through rehabilitation projects and design. Using the building back better strategy, we commit to environment-friendly and sustainable architecture.

BEIRUT BLAST SUPPORT

DONOR/PARTNER: MEDAIR/UNHCR

Status: Completed Budget: 311,185 USD

Time: Nov 2020 - Dec 2020

In collaboration with Medair funded by UNHCR, Live Love provided full rehabilitation for 69 homes and common areas that were moderately to heavily damaged from the Beirut blast.

Results: 69 homes and 3 common areas were fully rehabilitated (including exterior, interior, and mechanical/electrical repairs), and beneficiaries were able to return safely to their homes.





LEBANON ENTERPRISE AND EMPLOYMENT PROGRAMME

DONOR/PARTNER: LEEP/UKAID

Status: Completed Budget: 60,000 USD

Time: Dec 2020 - Apr 2021

Live Love collaborated with LEEP (Lebanon Enterprise and Employment Programme) and supported more than 40 Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) to grow their business and increase employment by providing funding and Business Development Services.

LEEP offers matching grants to micro, small and medium enterprises investing in repairs, either through self-investment, crowdfunding or other investments. If they have raised or are in the process of raising money for investment in repairs, we can match up to 50% of that with a LEEP grant, up to a ceiling of 60,000 USD.

The LEEP Programme is funded by UK Aid from the British people and implemented by Palladium.



REHABILITATION FOR RESIDENTIAL UNITS

DONOR/PARTNER: LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF/USAID

Status: Completed Budget: 66,000 USD Time: Feb 2021 - May 2021

In partnership with LWR, Live Love was able to rehabilitate 36 residential units with small to medium damage. The units included heritage and residential buildings in the areas of Rmeil, Bourj Hammoud, Achrafieh, Bachoura, Zoukak el Blat, and Mazraa.



MINOR REPAIRS: HOMES, OFFICES & SMES AFFECTED BY THE BEIRUT BLAST

DONOR/PARTNER: WINDOWS FOR BEIRUT THROUGH ARCHITECTES DE L'URGENCE

Status: Completed Budget: 60,000 USD Time: Dec 2020 - Apr 2021

In collaboration with Windows for Beirut, Live Love was able to provide shelter recovery focusing on the weatherproofing of 75 units including SMEs, offices and residential apartments. Reconstruction was mainly done to the façade of units ensuring the necessary conditions for households and businesses to return to their comfort.





BUILDINGS 1087 & 1088

DONOR/PARTNER: EMPLOYEES OF PHILLIP MORRIS INTERNATIONAL

Status: Completed Budget: 95,617.53 USD Time: Sept 2020 - Mar 2021

Employees of Philip Morris International launched a fundraising campaign, Projects with a Heart (PwH), to support projects helping those most affected by the Beirut Explosion. Through PwH we were able fully rehabilitate a building located next to the port of Beirut, PLOT Medawar 1087. Live Love fully repaired 35 units, including the full rehabilitation of the common area as well as façade repairs and paint.

We also painted the adjacent building facade to complement the work done on 1087 and beautify the street, making a bigger impact on the whole neighborhood.

REHABILITATION OF AZARIEH SCHOOL & FRERES GEMMAYZEH SCOUTS

DONOR/PARTNER: THW FOUNDATION THROUGH GERMAN EMBASSY

Status: Completed Budget: 35,528.33 USD Time: Mar 2021 - Sept 2021

Thanks to the funds provided by THW Foundation through the German Embassy, our team is working on the rehabilitation of two schools: Lazarists Fathers School and Azarieh School in Beirut. The project aims to create a community space for underprivileged children and youth in the area, to provide study and gathering spaces, as well as playing areas. Engaging youth in community life and activities allows them to better understand themselves and provides a healthy environment for them to grow up in and become valuable members of society. In a city like Beirut, and especially after the August 4th blast, spaces for youth gatherings and development have become very scarce. With the challenges facing the young community, especially with Covid-19 and homeschooling, underprivileged kids have found it very hard to adapt to the changes and their parents have found it challenging to provide appropriate studying materials and a quiet environment for them to study in.

SHELTER RECOVERY FOR RESIDENTIAL UNITS

DONOR/PARTNER: BEIRUT EMERGENCY FUND/SEAL

Status: Completed Budget: 55,818 USD

Time: Feb 2021 - Aug 2021

Through the Beirut Emergency Fund, Live Love has rehabilitated 30 homes with moderate to heavy damage from the Beirut Blast. The full repairs included exterior, interior, and mechanical/electrical work. This project is mitigating feelings of trauma by providing safe and comfortable conditions like weatherproofing, allowing individuals and families to return home.

LIGHT FOR LEBANON

DONOR/PARTNER: LIGHT REACH NETWORK

Status: Completed

Time: Jul 2021 - Dec 2021

Lebanon burns imported fuel (mostly highly polluting diesel) to generate electricity. Light Reach's solar lighting model presents a better way to quickly and sustainably re-illuminate Beirut. In collaboration with Live Love, the Light for Lebanon project secured 15 solar-powered street lights from Akawi Road to the Orthodox Hospital. In the next phase, we will be installing solar and sustainable lights in our Rmeil Cluster project.

BEIRUT BLAST RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION

DONOR/PARTNER: IMPACT LEBANON

Status: Ongoing

Budget: 400,000 USD Time: Jan 2021 - Ongoing

Funded by Impact Lebanon, our Beirut Blast Residential Rehabilitation project is working on the rehabilitation of a cluster of 10 heritage buildings. The Rmeil Cluster had been forgotten long before the Beirut August 4th blast. The area's challenging access, and its proximity to a planned and later cancelled infrastructure project, makes it a less privileged, disregarded part of the neighborhood. On August 4th, the cluster took a huge hit from the blast; the buildings in its limits were heavily damaged, some have even suffered on a structural level, and one building completely collapsed. The project extends outside the cluster to recover 16 medium to heavily damaged houses including 15 residential units and 1 common area.



REHABILITATION OF 10 HERITAGE BUILDINGS - RMEIL CLUSTER

DONOR/PARTNER: UN HABITAT/JAPANESE EMBASSY

Status: Ongoing

Budget: 1,000,000 USD Time: Mar 2021 - Ongoing

More recently, we applied for a call for proposal from UN Habitat to Rehabilitate 10 heritage buildings, and were fortunate enough to get awarded the AOC, allowing us to expand our scope of work in the Rmeil Cluster. The strategy adopted for the project is "Build Back Better", promoting flexibility and resilience when faced with future crises. It involves implementing disaster risk reduction measures including physical rehabilitation of buildings and reintegration of appropriate infrastructure, revitalization of livelihoods and the restoration of local culture and environment. The approach will enable us to ensure the building of greater resilience in disaster recovery and to increase the preparedness for future disasters, while also advancing urban resilience and green development. This project brings together other partners PARCIC and URDA who have supported the works through the implementation of a cash for work program within the rehabilitation site.






1.2-RELATIONS & RESPONSE

At the frontline of the crisis-relief efforts, the Relations & Response department deploys data collectors and dispatchers that dedicate their time and effort to connecting people in need to Live Love. The R&R department contacts beneficiaries, conducts emergency assessments, matches beneficiaries with the most suitable help available, then oversees the receiving of help by beneficiaries.

This department has a bright future. We are working on acquiring a call center software to increase our capacity of absorption, as well as becoming a self-sustainable department by selling our services to other organizations in the humanitarian sector.



The requests can vary from food, financial, medical to shelter sent directly to the call center or by other NGOs.



NGO RELATIONS

Following the Beirut Port Blast, the NGO Relations Department was created as part of Live Love's Disaster Management and Response Unit (DMRU) to develop and maintain key relationships with civil society organizations (CSOs) with the aim of forming a network for the coordination of humanitarian work in Lebanon (building on the Beirut Relief Coalition).

The department is committed to strengthening the local stakeholders' voices within the network itself as well as reaching out to a broader spectrum of CSOs.

It is responsible for mapping the civil society actors in the country and conducting liaisons to include the civil society actors into the coordination process.

The department aims to build capacity and empower local organizations to ensure a proactive and efficient provision of relief.

Live Love aims to show the beauty of Lebanon and its people. The work done by NGOs and personal initiatives after August 4th showcases the Lebanese will to help and assist each other in difficult times. It is only by working together and coordinating our work that we can build the Lebanon that we dream of at Live Love.

The formation of the Beirut Relief Coalition, a network of over 120 CSOs, helped coordinate the joint relief efforts of NGOs and personal initiatives following the August 4th blast.

We are currently re-assessing the situation of CSOs in order to build on the work done by the BRC. The objective is to build a new Coordination Hub allowing for the strengthening and empowerment of CSOs by means of enhanced and improved communication capabilities, capacity building through monthly workshops and more transparent and traceable donation mechanisms.



In partnership with RMF, Live Love organized a Christmas shopping experience for the vulnerable community of Beirut by rehabilitating a store in Beirut Souks into a Toy Store.

Live Love collaborated with 11 other NGOs to invite 2400 children.

These children were given vouchers to fulfill part of the Christmas experience, receiving toys and shoes.

"PROVISION OF FOOD PARCELS AND HYGIENE KITS" PROGRAM

Time: Sept 2020 - Mar 2021

Live Love partnered with Anera under their Provision of Food Parcels and Hygiene Kits Program funded by the Lebanon Humanitarian Fund. Through this program, we managed to distribute food parcels and Hygiene kits to 100 families affected by the blast in both Mar Mikhael and Gemmayzeh.



WOMEN-OWNED SMES

DONOR/PARTNER: UN WOMEN

Status: Completed Budget: 20,584.70 USD Time: Nov 2020 - Dec 2020

In partnership with UN Women and GCNL, Live Love provided in-kind support for 10 women-owned micro-small enterprises (WO-MSMEs) impacted by the Beirut Port Explosion. This project involved selecting 10 women-owned businesses in need of in-kind support in order to sustain their business operations, which were profiled based on a set of selection criteria determining their needs and sustainability of the business. We determined the type of in-kind support needed, completed the procurement process in order to ensure items were selected following UN Women's procurement policy -including best value for money, fairness, integrity and transparency- effective competition, and the best interests of UN Women; and delivered the in-kind donations to each business to allow business operations to resume.

THE SHABAKE PROJECT: ECONOMIC RECOVERY FOR LOCAL SMES THROUGH A DIGITIZED NETWORK

Budget: 211,797.82 -> 43,371.95 USD allocated to Live Love Time: Mar 2021 - Jan 2022

The Shabake project, in partnership with Expertise France, Arcenciel and DPNA, is aimed at providing financial support, rehabilitation and digital marketing to support the economic recovery of communities, small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) in areas most affected by the blast (Gemmayzeh, Mar Mikhael, Ashrafieh, Geitawi, Karantina, and Bourj Hammoud). As part of this project, Live Love is creating a digital voucher system, allowing 350 vulnerable families to purchase products from 8 local businesses and shops identified using vouchers.

RECOVERY, DEVELOPMENT AND CIVIL SOCIETY COORDINATION

DONOR/PARTNER: GIZ

Status: Ongoing

Budget: 200,000.11 EUROS Time: May 2021 - May 2022

Live Love is implementing a grant with the support of GIZ in Lebanon. Through this project, Live Love is striving to improve the coordination among civil society actors and provide capacity building activities. Thanks to GIZ, we are improving and developing our Disaster Management and Response Unit. We aim to provide needs-based support to vulnerable population groups and contribute to the reconstruction of Beirut.

Moreover, we have created sector-specific task forces with key actors in the field.

The sectors of intervention include Education, Health, Livelihoods, Heritage and Culture. To date, four workshops have been organized allowing task force members to improve their skills and knowledge. An ongoing assessment of CSOs' needs and challenges is being conducted as well as a mapping of their region and sector of activity. We are working towards developing a national coordination structure to ensure efficient and effective allocation of resources.

We operate within a mindset of inclusivity and collaborative governance to implement innovative tools for crisis management and coordination for all stakeholders involved.



DMRU AUTOMATION DONOR/PARTNER: IBM

Status: Ongoing

Time: Nov 2020 - Dec 2021

IBM is providing Live Love Lebanon consulting and technical services through the IBM Service Corps to identify short and long-term opportunities for improvement. The project has been ongoing since January with a team of full-time IBM employees to develop an automated platform for Live Love's work in disaster management and coordination.



EDUCATION TRUST FUND

DONOR/PARTNER: CARITAS + L'OEUVRE D'ORIENT + SECRÉTARIAT GÉNÉRAL DES ÉCOLES CATHOLIQUES AU LIBAN

Status: Just Started

Time: Dec 2021 - Dec 2022

Live Love has partnered with Caritas, L'oeuvre D'orient, and SGEC-L who are developing a platform to map schools and students across Lebanon, creating an effective unified education data management system to strengthen coordination in the sector and institutionalize crisis response and management for a more resilient education system. A fundraising campaign to support education access has been launched by Live Love to support student and schools that have been hit by the multiple crises in Lebanon.



3RF- RECOVERY, REFORM & RECONSTRUCTION

Status: Ongoing

Time: March 2021 - Ongoing until 2023

In March 2021, Live Love was selected as a member of the 3RF Consultative Group.

We believe that the inclusion of Civil Society in reform and recovery discussions is innovative and can yield immense results. We strongly believe that only by adopting a mindset of Collaborative Governance will we be able to address the many problems Lebanon faces. We have been heavily involved in each of the different pillars that the 3RF is focusing on. Live Love has attended several meetings where multi-level stakeholders addressed the challenges and opportunities concerning 1. reforms, governance and anti-corruption; 2. social inclusion, 3. Housing and culture; and, 4. SMES and MSMEs. We have done our best to align our coordination work under the GIZ grant with the priorities of the 3RF as we find significant synergies between the two. Live Love is using the 3RF platform to promote the voices of the CSOs we are in

As part of the 3RF Consultative Group, Live Love participated in the drafting of recommendations that were transferred to the stakeholders of the 3RF.

The work that was done throughout the year, brought together a list of recommendations from the CSOs. One of the recommendations that was taken was a Central Management Unit within the Prime Minister Office - to act as an executive role within public institutions. A decree was signed by the Prime Minister to institutionalize this Unit in his government.



1.3-HR & VOLUNTEERS

The HR Department is committed to fulfilling all the organization's members' needs, providing a stable work environment with equal opportunities and treatment, for proper professional development, constant learning and personal growth.

YOUTH-LED ACTIONS TO SUPPORT COMMUNITIES AFFECTED BY THE BEIRUT BLAST

DONOR/PARTNER: UNFPA

Status: Just Started

Time: Dec 2021 - Dec 2022

Thanks to UNFPA's funding, Live Love was able to implement a 6-month long project to mobilize, engage, and empower 100 youth volunteers. The program aimed to fortify volunteer capacities, motivation, and well-being in order to ensure the sustainability of Live Love's DMRU explosion recovery efforts, as well as to offer ample opportunities for targeted professional development and growth in order to create a strengthened path to future employment for the volunteers.

We provided the volunteers with 21 capacity building training sessions and 22 team building activities. The volunteers were matched to mentors in order to gain professional development and build networks in the career field of their choice.

And finally, free mental health support and life coaching sessions were made available to all of the volunteers.





NGO EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM / CFA

The IsDB-ISFD-NGO Empowerment for Poverty Reduction is a partnership program sponsored by The Islamic Solidarity Fund for Development (ISFD), managed by

The Islamic Development Bank (IsDB) and implemented by United Nations Development program (UNDP) and Live Love. The program sought to empower CSOs, mobilize resources and leverage expertise to eradicate poverty.

During 3 months, Live Love and UNDP provided mentorship to 20 CSOs under the Tadamon Crowdfunding Academy. CSOs received the knowledge and tools in alternative financing to increase their visibility and funds for their projects.

RISE2030 collaborated with Live Love by providing 72 volunteers that assisted in data collection, warehouse arrangement, and field work.

Volunteers in field work supported our Architecture & Planning Department in the reconstruction of a cluster; with more than 50 volunteers helping in cleaning up the Rmeil cluster project and providing support in construction work.





BEIRUT REMEMBERANCE TRAIL - REMEMBER NOT TO FORGET تنذكر لما تنعاد



4.1-INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITIES

LIVE LOVE NORTH CAROLINA

Live Love NC has been an incredible experience for us Raleigh natives to get to know our area better. Through the past few months we have collaborated with organizations that have a direct impact on the youth and environment of our community.

In April we hosted a trash pick up alongside one of Raleigh's many city owned paths. We chose this location because we knew it ran through an underserved area and ran along a water source. With 13 attendants including our team, we were able to collect over 30 pounds of trash within 2 hours.

We used a method of divide and conquer in order to reach more surface area. We had some volunteers focus on picking up litter along the water, some along the road and the rest of the team worked on the paved path.



LIVE LOVE ARMENIA

We are very proud of mentioning that Live Love Armenia has been a key supporter in different causes and organizations within the country.

Firstly, part of the sales-profits go to different organizations such as: Armenia Tree Project, Fuller House Armenia, One Armenia and Bridge of Hope. Furthermore,

our Live Love Ambassadors have supported these causes in person, attending and helping with several activities and events. On April 3rd, 2021, 30 Live Love Armenia volunteers and the Armenia Tree Project planted 80 trees in honor of our ancestors and for the future of our homeland. Under the umbrella of our Live Love Nature Pillar, we believe that when we plant a tree we are essentially exercising FAITH in life, HOPE for the future, and LOVE for people and the planet.
