Description of Our Actions in 2022

Human Rights

- We continue to only work with growers/suppliers that share out company values and ethical business practices. In 2022, we established a new and comprehensive supplier audit program which puts a focus on human rights, in addition to our suppliers' labour, environment, and anti-corruption efforts.
- We have expanded the scope of our auditing functionality to include consideration for Indigenous Australians.
- We have commenced work towards our first Reflect RAP (Reconciliation Action Plan)

Labour

- Down Under Enterprises maintains a female staff employed ratio of ~50%.
- Down Under Enterprises is a female owned company.
- Our team is a diverse group, with members originating from Europe, South America, North America, Asia, and Australia.
- We continue to monitor KPIs for accidents, employee training and employee social benefits. These are tracked and reported annually.

Environment

- We continue to monitor environmental KPIs for waste, recycling, water, and energy; these are tracked and reported annually.
- Repurposing waste product (Hydrosol) to prevent it being released into the environment.
- Rainwater harvesting is employed for warehouse and irrigation on our farms.
- 100% renewable energy is exclusively used for our offices and our farms.

Anti-Corruption

- We manage all our external parties according to our Anti-Corruption Policy.
- As part of the Australian Trusted Trader program (Australian Federal Government Border Force), we conduct risk assessments to ensure no corrupt or unethical practices take place across our entire supply chain.
