To our stakeholders:

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a CEO statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

We are late in creating, sharing, and posting our COP report due to additional work we have undertaken this year as an organisation, in expanding our ESG disclosure through our online ESG Databook, to be released on 18 November 2022.

Concurrently, given the timing of our COP and the imminent launch of the new UNGC COP Reporting portal and annualised reporting rhythm, we are keen not unnecessarily duplicate reporting efforts, but instead focus our time and resourcing on preparing to submit in the new portal when it becomes available in early 2023.

We hereby ask for an extension period in order to be able to post a COP that describes our company's efforts and progress to implement the principles of the UN Global Compact. Our new COP report will be posted in the new UN Global Compact online reporting portal in March 2023.

It is our intention to align with the new online Annual COP reporting rhythm as soon as we can to make it easier for our stakeholders to understand our progress and compare us with our peers. We thank you for your understanding during this time of transition.
