This letter is to advise you that MJ Celco, Inc. has spent the past year supporting the ten guidelines that the Global Compact has outlined with respect to human rights, labor, environment, and anti-corruption. Our customers, vendors, and community businesses continue to be made aware of our strong support of these very important issues. As stated in last year's letter to the United Nations, we will continue our commitment to making a clear statement of this to our stakeholders on an annual basis and to the general public, as well as adhere to OSHA regulations and national labor standards.

During the last year, we participated, in both customer and supplier audits focusing on the Ten Principles. We continue to see more changes in the diversity of MJ Celco's workforce. In addition, we continue to the company-wide suggestion program. In addition we have been introduced to a more dedicated manner of environmental sustainability.

As part of our efforts to support the environmental principles of the Global Compact, we continued a project to reduce emissions from our production process. We expanded a program with our suppliers to reduce our incoming expendable packaging. We finished the re-designed our packaging department with user-friendly workstations (removing repetitive motions). We, as a company, will continue to undertake initiatives such as this to promote greater environmental responsibility.
