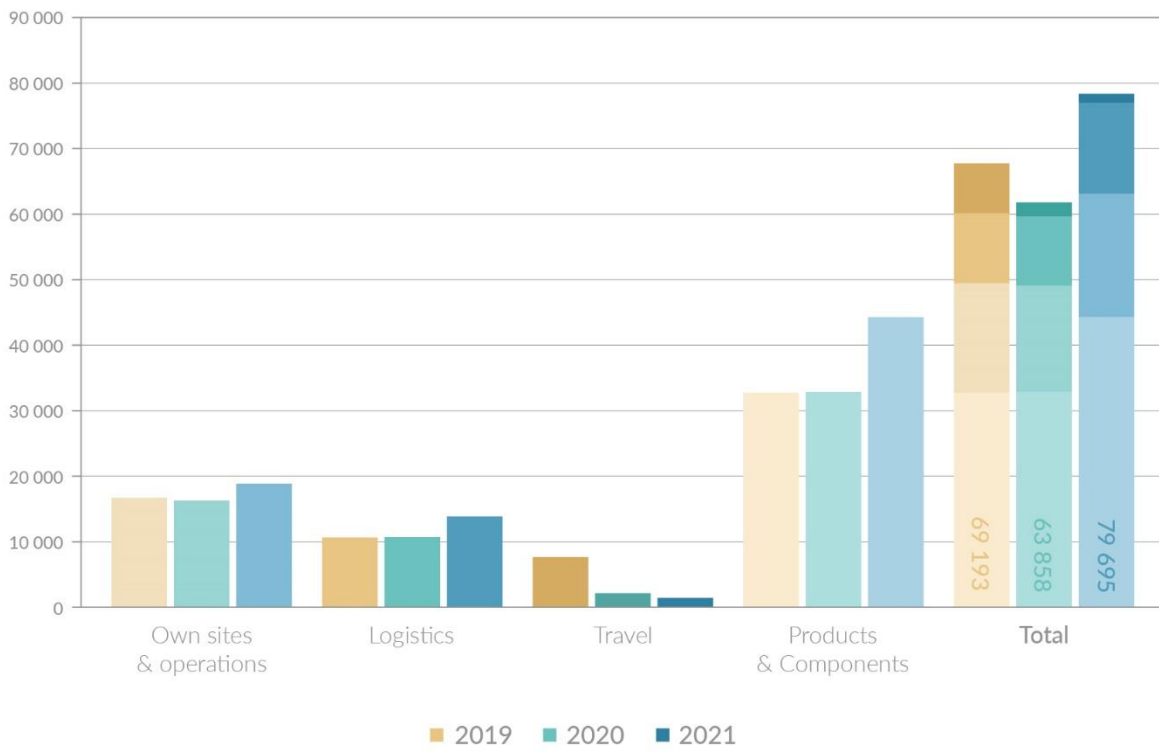


2021 Carbon Emission Update

Climate Accounting Emission Development 2019 – 2021 (ton CO₂e)



Laerdal is measuring emission in all parts of the organization. The emission numbers include scope 1, 2 and 3.

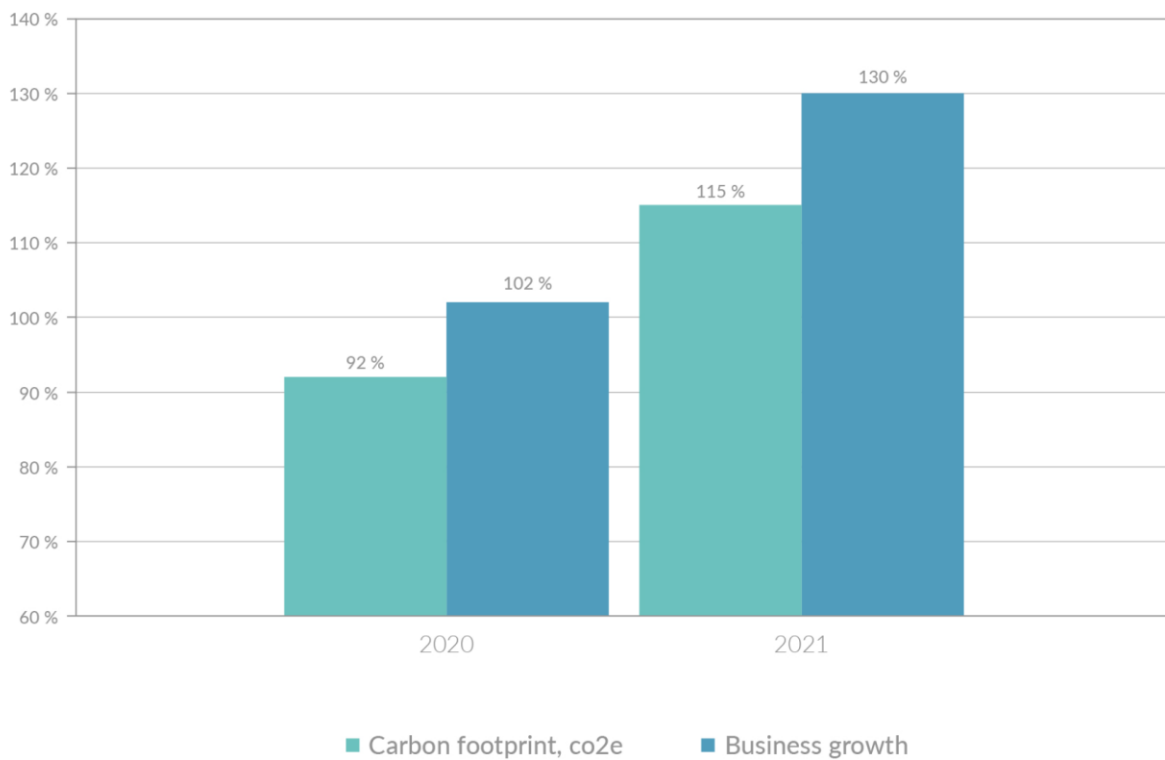
In 2020, we set a bold ambition of becoming carbon neutral by 2030. In the last two years, we have increased our focus and initiated many initiatives such as the installation of solar panels in our production sites and the focus on sustainability in product development.

Even though several important emission reduction initiatives have been taken, we have seen an increase in our absolute emissions due to;

- Increases in business. Compared to the 2019 baseline, business has increased by 30% and emissions 15%.

- Increase in emissions due to Covid19 pandemic disruptions and increase in unplanned air shipments.
- Important improvements to materials are concluded but not yet reflected in present sales and emission numbers. This work will be further strengthened by the detailed Life Cycle Assessment conducted on our most important products

In relative numbers, we see that carbon emission has increased with 15% while the business has grown with 30% from 2019 - 2021
