Part II. Description of Actions

A) Healthcare

Htoo Foundation Clinic at Putao, Kachin State



Since 2012, HTOO Foundation has been operating HTOO Foundation Charity Clinic in Putao State, Myanmar, with the aim of providing health care to locals all year round. Through March 2012-2022, a total of over 24,155 patients were examined and provided healthcare by appointed medical staff.

B) Activities In Relation To Labor

Below are HTOO foundation's *internal implementation* on activities in relation to Labor.



Htoo Foundation provides all of its employees with a healthy working environment free from harassment or bullying. There is no discrimination on the grounds of gender, marital status, age, religion, physical ability, sexual orientation, political beliefs or social class in the workplace. HTOO foundation provides opportunities for young Myanmar people to participate in local community development by providing volunteering opportunity.

Htoo Foundation complies with Myanmar Labor law for all its employees, by providing transparent leave policies, compensation policies, enrollment of social security and extensive training programmes and opportunities.

C) Environment

Principle 8: Undertake initiatives to promote greater environmental responsibility

HTOO Foundation follows and practices the environmental conservation law laid down in the republic of union of Myanmar. We always try to reduce its use of resources in terms of electricity consumption, water, fuel, plastic and paper. Carpooling, reuse of scrap paper and minimization of printed material and paper copies is encouraged at organization. Plastic bottles, scrap papers and other recyclable materials are donated to private collectors.





In 2021 and 2022, Htoo Foundation, in collaboration with the Forestry Department, conducted a rainy season tree planting in the protected forest of Banbwegon Dam, near Nyaung Wine village, Kyauktan Township, Yangon Division, on the morning of June 25th, 2021 and June 24th 2022. 1500 and 2000 various species of shady tree (such as of Lagerstroemia speciose, Mahogany, etc.) total over the 4 acres of land were planted by HTOO Foundation members in this annual tree planting event.



D) Anti-Corruption

Principle 10: Business should work against all forms of corruption, including extortion and bribery.

Being a Non-profit Organization, HTOO foundation does not sell services or make income, and exempted from income tax. All public and private contributions, expenses from its activities are transparently submitted to Ministry of Home Affairs annually with a full comprehensive report.

HTOO Foundation committed to be an accountable, responsible and zero tolerance approach to corruption and free from any illegal practices. We have a standard and believe in communication with all donators and our staff. HTOO Foundation has no case against corruption as we continue to follow the guidance from UNGC.



E) Education



In 2021 and 2022, celebration of the 13th and 14th anniversary of HTOO Foundation, we donated of food and personal items along with daily nutrition, milk powder box, which is needed to Y.G.W Charity Orphan Care and Monastic Education School in Thanach Chaug Village, Yangon Region. YGW Charitable Orphan Care and Monastic Education School is currently nurturing a total of (480) children from birth to high school age, including (66) children from birth to infancy.

HTOO foundation also supported educational scholarships for a number of children who required financial assistance with the aim to promote access of education by every course of the community.



Part III. Measurement of Outcomes

All the above activities engaged by HTOO foundation in the mentioned period were carefully considered the application of the Global Compact's aims and designed to support the Global Compact principals. Our activities and campaigns internally and externally have resulted in increasing the awareness of human rights and gender equality in our local communities.
