

"AJIALOUNA" ORGANIZATION IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION ENGAGED IN CHARITABLE, CULTURAL, SOCIAL, HEALTHCARE, AND EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS. FOUNDED IN BEIRUT ON MARCH 1, 1995, AJIALOUNA FUNCTIONS UNDER THE DECREE NUMBER 41/AD.

Since its establishment, Ajialouna's mandate has been to serve the local Lebanese community as a whole, without any restrictions based on religious sect or nationality; a unique sanction in Lebanon. #### **PHARMACIES**

Located within Ajialouna's Medical Centers in Beirut and Tripoli, the pharmacies are supervised by full-time pharmacists and three volunteers with Pharmacy degrees.

All services and medications are provided free of charge. 90% of the medication is purchased by Ajialouna and the rest is donated as samples from drug companies, hospitals and private clinics

### 2. HEALTH AWARENESS

## "ANA KABERT" IS A HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAM THAT STARTED IN 2001 TO PROMOTE AWARENESS AND EDUCATION FOR THE GIRLS' PHYSICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL CHANGES DURING PUBERTY

- The program targets 17,000 girls annually between the ages of 11-14 years in both public and private schools across Lebanon.
- Trained midwives provide health education on the physical and psychological changes during puberty.
- "ANA KABERT" is generously financed by Procter and Gamble.



# LAUNCHED IN 1995 IN COLLABORATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF EDUCAITON, THE SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAM IS ONE OF AJIALOUNA'S PIONEER PROJECTS CONSISTING OF DENTAL AND PUBLIC HEALTH CLINICS

- Managed by a medical health team of professional doctors, dentists, registered nurses, pharmacists and administrative volunteers, the program provides elementary students in 30 public schools (15 schools in Beirut and 15 in Tripoli) with routine medical screening.
- Family medicine doctors and pediatricians consult, diagnose and follow up with students in elementary public schools and their families.
- Medication, diagnostic physiotherapy and hospitalization when needed are provided and sponsored by Aiialouna.




## 2. HEALTH AWARENESS CONT'D

#### SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAM

At the beginning of each academic year, newly enrolled students undergo a general physical screening, and then are:

- Referred (if necessary) to a specialist at Ajialouna Medical Center;
- Examined by the physician at school-based district clinic;
- Provided with needed diagnostics such as lab tests and X-rays, medications are provided onsite;
- Referred for surgeries if required;
- Scheduled for follow-up on a timely basis.

## **HEALTHCARE** - MEDICAL HOTLINE PROGRAM



2020 MARKS THE 6<sup>TH</sup> YEAR OF OUR MEDICAL HOTLINE PROGRAM WHICH ENABLES UNDERPRIVILEGED PATIENTS IN NEED OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO RECEIVE SWIFT APPROVALS TO COVER FINANCIAL COSTS OF TIME-SENSITIVE TREATMENTS AND EMERGENCY OPERATIONS.

Within 24 hours, a medical applicant's request for assistance is reviewed and verified by our Medical Validation Team. Due diligence is carried out by verifying information received, the patient's medical history and calls with physicians and medical facilities.


Approved cases are funded the difference between what is coffered by the National Social Security Fund ("NSSF") or the Ministry of Public Health ("MOPH") by Ajialouna, with payments made directly to facilities and hospitals.

### **HEALTHCARE** - MEDICAL HOTLINE PROGRAM





Today, with the generous and kind donation of a specific funding party, Ajialouna extended its community of healthcare services into remote/rural areas of families from no-income to low-income socioeconomic background via a Mobile Health Clinic. This project serves as part of the activities

Ajialouna is involved in and is in line with Ajialouna's mission.

During these site visits, The Mobile Clinic team provided comprehensive high-quality service to all age groups (Children, adolescents, adults, and elderly). Services include the following:

- Medical assessment of acute complaints such as fever, cough, abdominal pain, etc.
- Management of acute conditions such as otitis, tonsillitis, cystitis, etc.
- Screening of non-communicable diseases such as diabetes mellitus, and hypertension
- Screening for mental health conditions
- Management of chronic diseases
- Reproductive healthcare services such as family planning
- Health education on different topics including self-hygiene, exercise, healthy diet, etc.







## AJIALOUNA'S PROMINENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM "TOMOOH" WAS LAUNCHED IN 2006 IN COLLABORATION WITH PEPSICO INTERNATIONAL & TARGETS UNIVERSITY STUDENTS BETWEEN THE AGES OF 18-22 IN LEBANON

- \*TOMOOH promotes social development through education and targets underprivileged students who are academically gifted, providing them with academic scholarships to pursue their higher education.
- The payment is settled directly with the educational institution by Ajialouna.

#### **Tomooh Student Scholarship Program Data (2006-2022)**










In 2020-2021, Tomooh program assisted 355 students in private and public universities.

## 4. SOCIAL AFFAIRS

ESTABLISHED IN 1995, THE SOCIAL AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT INCLUDES THREE PROGRAMS THAT PROVIDE FINANCIAL, MATERIAL AND IN-KIND SUPPORT FOR ORPHANS, WIDOWS, UNDERPRIVILEGED FAMILIES AND INDIVIDUALS

- 48 Palestinian Families.

#### **ORPHANS and WIDOWS SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM**

Ajialouna plays the role of a mediator between the sponsor and the beneficiary. The sponsorship covers annual educational fees, healthcare and social benefits. This program is also dedicated to assist women who support their families. The social department annually helps more than **800 Orphans** in need under this program. The program is financed by Zakat donations and other fundraising activities.

Ajialouna has the highest percentage of Zakat donations for programs that target women, children and the elderly, setting a leading example in Lebanon.

As part of its social initiative during Ramadan, Ajialouna often collaborates with different organizations to distribute financial and in-kind donations.



## 5. WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

LAUNCHED IN 2010, THE WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM IS A CAREER-ORIENTED PROGRAM PROVIDING BASIC EDUCATION AND TRAINING FOR UNDERPRIVILEGED WOMEN TO HELP THEM LAUNCH A CAREER AND GAIN ECONOMIC INDEPENDENCE

A free program dedicated to women between the ages of 18 and 50.

The program aims to improve the role of the working woman in the Lebanese community and to provide her with the opportunity to secure a job in the following fields:

- Cooking
- Cosmetology
- Computer skills
- Elderly Caretaker
- Nurse Assistant

#### THE ATELIER & ARTWORK

Launched in Beirut (2005) and in Tripoli (2009), the aim of the atelier is to promote the empowerment of women and strengthen their role in the community.

THE STAFF ARE COMPRISED OF 25 UNDERPRIVILEGED WOMEN AND WIDOWS OF FEMALE RUN HOUSEHOLDS AND ARE SUPERVISED BY AN EXPERIENCED CHEF AND COMPLETES CONTINUOUS TRAININGS WITHIN THE WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM.

The COFUR DE MIEL Kitchen abides by and implements quality manufacturing standards and handles catering requests six days a week. Our dynamic production area at the Ajialouna premises offers Lebanese cuisine, international cuisine and dessert for all occasions across Lebanon. For catered events, the kitchen also provides necessary supplies including utensils, serving equipment, tables, chairs tablecloths and waiters.

**EDUCATION ASSISTANCE** 

 S.O.S is a social empowerment program aiming at putting a halt to the fast deterioration of the Lebanese educational sector. The program's first phase will focus on reversing skyrocketing illiteracy and dropout rates among students.

## RENT PAYMENTS

- Amid October 2019, Ajialouna commenced its Cash for Rent Assistance Program to cover rent for families no longer able to meet their shelter needs.
- This program covers between 3 to 12 months of rent for households to ensure the continuity of a safe shelter environment for children and their families.



ELDERLY CAREGIVER PROJECT  Ajialouna collaborated with "Qudurat" to train and prepare 20 females to become practical nurses whom would be able to take care of 20 senior citizens, who are already beneficiaries of Ajialouna's medical services.

PEPSI CO. SCHOLARSHIP

- Pepsi Scholarship to support Ajialouna's educational assistance with a new fund that covers total scholarships for students in the Lebanese University.
- Beneficiaries are requested to help in sorting glass bottles on their campuses. The collected and arranged glass bottles will be recycled, and the revenues would fund their succeeding year(s).


