

## **United Nations Global Compact Communication on Engagement (CoE) 2022/2023**

**1. Statement by the chief executive** or equivalent expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing the participant's ongoing commitment to the initiative

### **2021**

April/May:

- In addition to the membership in the European Alliance for Subject-Specific and Professional Accreditation and Quality Assurance (EASPA) and the Asia-Pacific Cultural Centre for UNESCO, iuventum also continued its membership in the International Certification Accreditation Council (ICAC).

June to October:

- iuventum made updates to its programs, in particular with regard to the ESD Forum online, the Space Program and Global Course.

## **2022**

January to November:

- Representatives attended meetings at UN University in Tokyo, Japan; conferences at UN Headquarters in New York, US; and visited other sites to discuss further activities. Moreover, steps to establish education/learning centers were taken.

December:

- iuventum discussed initial plans for another ESD Forum and new onsite activities.

## **2023**

January:

- Hisashi Saito became United Nations (UN) Organization Main Representative and Brian Cole became United Nations (UN) Organization Special Representative.
- Plans continue to establish education/learning centers; discussions took place with other entities and people mainly in Germany and the US.

February:

- iuventum prepared and submitted new CoE for the UN Global Compact.

### **3. Measurement of outcomes** (ie. qualitative / quantitative measurement of results)

iuventum has continued to maintain and increase its network, including membership in the European Alliance for Subject-Specific and Professional Accreditation and Quality Assurance (EASPA) and ACCU, the Asia-Pacific Cultural Centre for UNESCO.

Moreover, iuventum is continuing the ESD Forum online and planning further education programs and activities onsite and online.
