

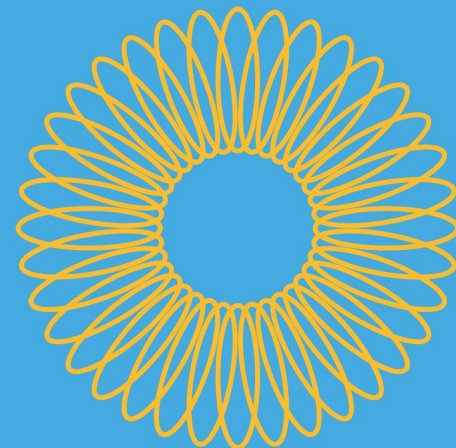
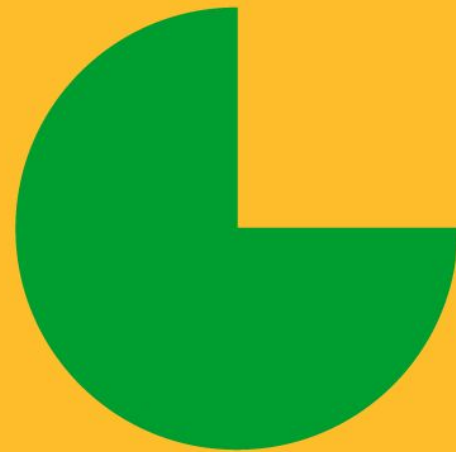


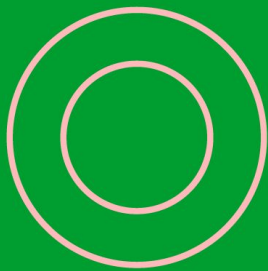

However, at Osvitoria, we continued to pursue our vision even in the midst of these tragic events in our country.

Our tactics may have changed, but not our strategy.

Our front line is education.

This year, our efforts focused on ensuring the resilience of the educational process through quality projects and products.

Osvitoria has confirmed and solidified its position as a leader in the education sector of Ukraine. Our organization has become the largest partner of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine and the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF Ukraine) in terms of the number of implemented projects.

Osvitoria has become a true beacon of resilience and trust in the educational landscape, not only for teachers, students, and their parents, but also for partners within Ukraine and beyond.

I'm never tired of saying that education is a tool that develops and shapes the future of a nation, society, and culture. And the transformative educational projects we have been able to implement this year are just small fragments that enable us to support the learning process and provide education to a new generation of Ukrainians.

In this report, we succinctly share our projects and their results. But behind each project is a team of project managers, educators, experts, communicators, and IT specialists, and their diligent work amidst alarms and blackouts. These results are our unique struggle for what Ukrainians will be like tomorrow, in a year, 10 years, and beyond.

The full-scale war in Ukraine presented educators with a series of challenges: from the total uncertainty of the future to the need to preserve the educational process itself, from integrating students who are studying from abroad to supporting the emotional state of teachers. Therefore, all the projects implemented by Osvitoria in 2022 were aimed at providing comprehensive assistance to the educational process and all its participants in the conditions of war.

Our key partners in this work were the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF Ukraine), War Child Holland, TED, PACT, and others.

We have strengthened the operational resilience of our organization by successfully completing a series of international audits, such as Due Diligence and HACT (Harmonized Approach to Cash Transfer).

Throughout the year, our team, in collaboration with partners, implemented 16 large-scale projects.

*Despite the war, iLearn, First Profession, Global Teacher Prize Ukraine, and others projects continued to develop in 2022. With the "I Understand" course, **we helped teachers understand their own emotional state and provided tools to stabilize the emotional well-being of children.** Through the osvitanow.org platform and the "Together for Learning" project, we shared information on **how to continue education during times of war.** Additionally, **we continued working on the New Ukrainian School reform** and trained coaches who now educate teachers in different regions all over Ukraine.*

Our online projects provided an opportunity for 2 million Ukrainian students from 70 countries around the world, including temporarily occupied territories, to learn, successfully pass tests, and complete secondary education.

The results of these projects demonstrate that education in Ukraine continues to develop and that the involved educators think in terms of the future. This gives us confidence and inspiration that after victory, we will be able to overcome future challenges and further develop and elevate our education to a new level.

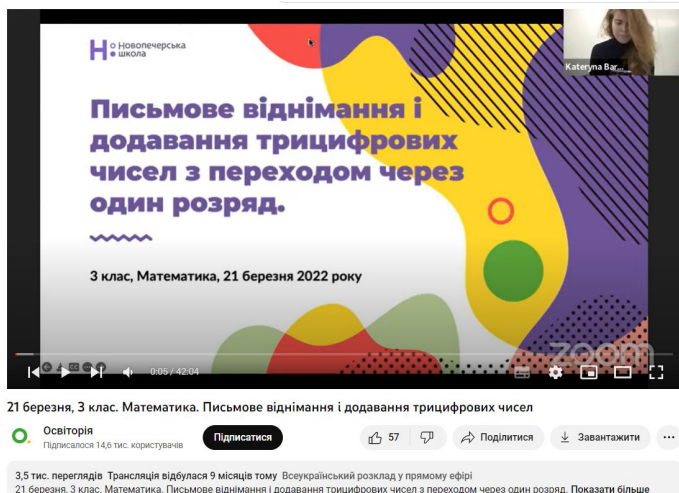

Ukrainian Schedule Online

The Ukrainian Schedule Online Project created by “Osvitoria” NGO in partnership with the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine and the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF Ukraine) aimed to support children during war time in 2022.

The streams developed in accordance with the themes of the school program and grades. Only experienced fighters of the educational frontier leded them: finalists of the Global Teacher Prize Ukraine, teachers of the All-Ukrainian Online School, Novopecherska School and experts of Osvitoria.

- Osvitoria's team returned the educational routine to the children from the first months of the full-scale war in Ukraine.
- Pupils from all regions, including temporarily occupied territories, were involved into the continued educational process.

All-Ukrainian Online School - the first and only national platform for blended and distance learning in Ukraine, created by Osvitoria at the request of the state.

The All-Ukrainian Online School rescued students and teachers during the COVID-19 pandemic and became an integral part of school life later. Since the beginning of the war, when 60% of children have left their homes and schools, the project is helping to restore the learning process.

- 1,371 new lessons* were developed in six months, now there are more than 3,500 lessons on the platform
- Developed instructions and methodological recommendations for the implementation of AUSO for teachers and volunteers who work with internally displaced children and translated into 14 languages. The Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine submitted this to the Ministries of Education and Science of the EU countries

Training and methodological support for teachers

Osvitroria's Training Center - a place for the development and inspiration of educators, where everyone will find their own direction for learning — from webinars to full-fledged trainings.

- 40,000 teachers were trained during 2022 — from the first program "Peculiarities of working with children with SEN" in January to a webinar about the applications for teachers in December 2022.

New Ukrainian School reform support

Free training of teachers for the implementation of the reform of the New Ukrainian School.

- *We have created a full-fledged online course with answers to all teachers' questions about the reform of the NUS, which will not lose its relevance in the future.*
- *They made sure that the NUS reform was introduced to every town in Ukraine: they trained trainers who helped to ensure the training of teachers in the field.*

Professional Development Program for Educational Leaders

A six-month training program for principals of public and private schools, heads of education departments and founders of educational startups or projects, who, together with their teams, seek to change the education system in their institutions and communities. We implement the program together with Kyiv-Mohyla Business School.

- *The challenge in 2022 was to create a relevant program that would be of great value in wartime.*
- *10 modules during 10 months of war*

Education During War: Information Support and Tools for Teachers and Parents

Osvita Now + Together for Learning

The initiative to support the education of children in the conditions of restrictions and challenges due to the war, created in partnership with “Osvitoria” NGO, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF Ukraine) and the first lady Olena Zelenska.

- We created an online platform [OsvitaNow](https://osvitanow.org/) for parents and teachers about education during the war with tools for organizing the educational process, a list of useful resources, and safety instructions.
- Over **500,000** unique users visited the platform in **6 months**
- Prepared and launched the training course for teachers **"Together for Learning: effective and safe education during war"**.
- **3,000 schools** were provided with informational posters.

**Creating learning opportunities
for all children**

Scholarship program

We provide an opportunity for talented, capable children, whose families are unable to pay for education and/or find themselves in difficult life circumstances, to obtain a high-quality full secondary education, receive social and psychological support and develop leadership skills at the Novopechersk school.

- *We held the first set of the Social Program — we received 200 applications from students in grades 1-11. For the first time, children from all over Ukraine are studying under the Scholarship Program.*
- *Among 104 applications, 6 applicants were chosen to study under the Scholarship Program.*

The First Profession


This project makes sure that orphans and social orphans in Ukraine are not afraid of an unemployed future. We are teaching young teenagers up to 10 simple professions. During these free training courses, they also learn to dream and achieve their goals while mastering their first profession to earn a living.

We do not give fish, but fishing rods.

- 50% of the coverage of the project during the war managed to be preserved: **25 workshops in 13 institutions in 7 regions of Ukraine**
- A special project was implemented - all workshop-residents joined in and

are acquiring skills in their first profession.



Global Teachers Prize Ukraine: Recognizing Heroes on the Educational Frontline



GLOBAL TEACHER PRIZE **UKRAINE**

Annual national award for teachers-agents of educational change. The award is designed to celebrate the achievements of teachers for children and society and to emphasize the importance of teachers in Ukraine.

- *In a short period of time, the award was adapted to the new context and hundreds of stories about wartime teachers were collected to convey to society: "Teachers are important. Despite all!"*
- *For the first time in 6 years, the award was held in a new format — without the presentation of statuettes and a red carpet ceremony, but as always about the importance of teachers, especially on the educational front.*

*The broadcast of the Award in the national telethon received **10 million views***

- *We completely transformed our Instagram and Viber pages, turning them into separate online communities*

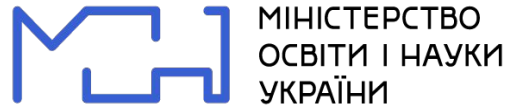
