We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the biannual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises a statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

We are late in sharing our COP report due to an internal oversight that made us realize we need to adapt the documents to the specific COP format, even though we collected the required data and prepared the necessary reports in advance. We want to ensure that our COP report not only meets the UN Global Compact standards but also presents our data in the most clear and coherent manner possible.
