The United Nations volunteers of Saint Mary's Academy in Meerut Cantt organized a drawing competition for underprivileged children, with a total of 90 children under the age of 16. The competition was divided into three categories: below five years, 11 years, and 16 years, with two winners selected in each category. The children displayed excellent creativity and came up with beautiful designs and ideas.

A check-up camp was organized by a team from Neutema Hospital. All the children were examined for deficiencies in iron and calcium, and appropriate medicines were prescribed. Calcium and vitamin D tablets, deworming tablets, iron tonics, fever medicines for kids, and fever tablets were distributed. Oral check-ups were also conducted to examine the children for any dental issues or tooth ailments.
