On Tuesday 18 July 2023 from 8:30 a.m.–12:00 p.m. EDT, the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (DESA), the UN Global Compact, the International Organisation of Employers (IOE) and the World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) will co-host the SDG Global Business Forum at the UN Headquarters in New York alongside the UN High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF).

Not only that, the meeting emphasized how the new Global Partnership monitoring exercise will provide evidence of development effectiveness, contribute to reporting on the SDGs (The Sustainable Development Goals) which aim at sustainable development (TPB) which covers various social and economic development issues. as well as improving the quality of the VNR (Voluntary National Report) for the country.

From the UIPM USA who was present as an Observer, one of them, Rantastia Nur Alangan, said that he provided full support to carry out the program with sustainable goals in all aspects of life in the Asia Pacific.
