 bore
- Target Placement: On a tree or on the ground using a metal or wood stand
- Eligibility: Open to everyone,
 regardless of gender or age
- License Requirement: Not necessary
- Ammunition: No restrictions
- Carrying a Gun: Not compulsory;
 participants can borrow on the spot for free
- Clean Hit: When water pours out of the coconut
- Participation: Over 200 individuals
- Distance to Target: 80 meters on the ground, 20 to 50 meters on a tree
- Objective: To encourage and promote fun shooting sports in Coorg

- Club member: Mrs. Teena Machaiah, UN Women Designate in India


Participants (Student UN Volunteers-India)
