SETI follows the guidelines of the environmental policy of the Government of Paraná, whose responsibilities are the State Secretariat for Sustainable Development - SEDEST, according to Law n° 21352/2023, article 37, below. SETI proceeds with the selective separation of recyclable administrative solid waste generated in the performance of its activities, as recommended by Decree 8426/2017, which provides for the mandatory selective separation of recyclable administrative solid waste generated by bodies and entities of the Executive Branch. SETI established a Selective Collection Committee, through Resolution No. 094/2023-SETI, under the terms of Decree No. 8426/2017.

According to Law No. 21352/2023, article 37, aiming at the sustainable development of the State of Paraná, the State Secretariat for Sustainable Development - SEDEST is responsible for:

I - the formulation, coordination, execution and development of public policies:

- a) of protection, conservation and restoration of natural heritage;
- b) of water resources management;
- c) of environmental sanitation, especially:
 1. water supply, particularly in relation to the drilling of deep tubular wells;
 2. urban drainage for prevention and containment of urban erosion and flood control and prevention;

 4. domestic sewage;
- d) territorial management and land regularization of vacant lands;
- e) mineral and geological;
- f) cartographic and geoprocessing;

II - monitoring the implementation of public policies and the integration of activities in order to ensure the protection and preservation of the environment.
